Project Update WIS 190 - Capitol Drive County F to Brookfield Rd. August 31, 2018



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Southeast Region continues progress on rehabilitation of pavement and bridges on west Capitol Drive.

August Progress

Department contractors completed all Stage 2 concrete pavement/base repairs (outside driving lanes) and lower layers of asphalt pavement. Barker Rd. was closed on August 6th to complete grading for widening, and paving of lower layers of asphalt and reopened on Friday August 20th. Contractors completed structural overlays at the Fox River and the eastbound bridge over Duplainville Rd. and completed majority of guardrail and guardrail end treatments at all bridges.

Electrical contractor completed all installation of new underground conduits and installation of signal bases for new signals at both Springdale and Barker Road.

Scheduled Work—Construction Impacts

Department contractor will complete guard rail installations, installation of new signal equipment, and begin final asphalt surfacing and final pavement marking.

<u>Traffic Impacts/Stage Changes (Contingent on Weather)</u>

- Asphalt Surfacing will begin the week of September 3rd and continue through the weeks of September 10th and 17th.
- Single lane closures will continue to be used, including for some peak hours of travel, primarily during the week of September 10th, to complete asphalt surfacing. Department will work to minimize peak hour impacts.
- Off peak hour (8:30am to 3pm) single lane closures will be utilized after Monday September 17th through mid October to complete guardrail, pavement marking, and project restoration.
- Springdale Rd and Baker Rd. will be alternately closed for overnight asphalt surfacing operations during the week of September 17th. Single night for each closure—a 7pm to early morning. Advance message signs will identify overnight closures.
