WIS 100 Winter Configuration

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is well underway with the reconstruction of WIS 100 from just north of Edgerton Avenue to just south of College Avenue, with scheduled completion in 2019.

Winter shutdown is scheduled for mid-December with crews to resume work in spring of 2019. The winter traffic configuration will be as follows:

Northbound WIS 100:


- Two through lanes of traffic on the newly constructed east side of WIS 100 pavement and curblane.
- Left turns allowed at College Avenue, Kay Parkway, Forest Home Avenue, Janesville Road, Grange Avenue, Abbott Avenue, and Edgerton Avenue.

Southbound WIS 100

- Two through lanes of traffic on temporary pavement in the old median.
- Left turns allowed at College Avenue, Janesville Road, Scharles Avenue, Grange Avenue, Abbott Avenue, and Edgerton Avenue.

Forest Home Avenue, Grange Avenue, Edgerton Avenue and Janesville Road will be fully reopened for the winter shutdown period.

**Travelers should be aware of the new traffic pattern, use only designated left turn locations, obey traffic control signs and pavement markings, and drive safely throughout the work zone.*
