

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Background

- The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) has completed an environmental assessment and Finding of No Significant Impacts (FONSI) and is now preparing final construction plans for the proposed County KR improvements between County H and Old Green Bay Road in Racine and Kenosha counties. The project begins 400 feet east of the County KR/County H intersection and extends east for 2.8 miles to end 1,600 feet east of the County KR/Old Green Bay Road intersection.
- The project is scheduled to be LET next July with construction beginning sometime in August. It is anticipated that construction will take 24 months to complete.
- WisDOT, Racine County and Kenosha County entered into a state trunk highway jurisdictional transfer agreement in April 2018 for the County KR improvements between I-94 and Old Green Bay Road. The agreement allows WisDOT to complete design and construction activities for this section of County KR. The counties are responsible for right of way acquisition and relocations. After construction, WisDOT will return jurisdiction of the roadway to the counties for ongoing control, access rights and maintenance.
