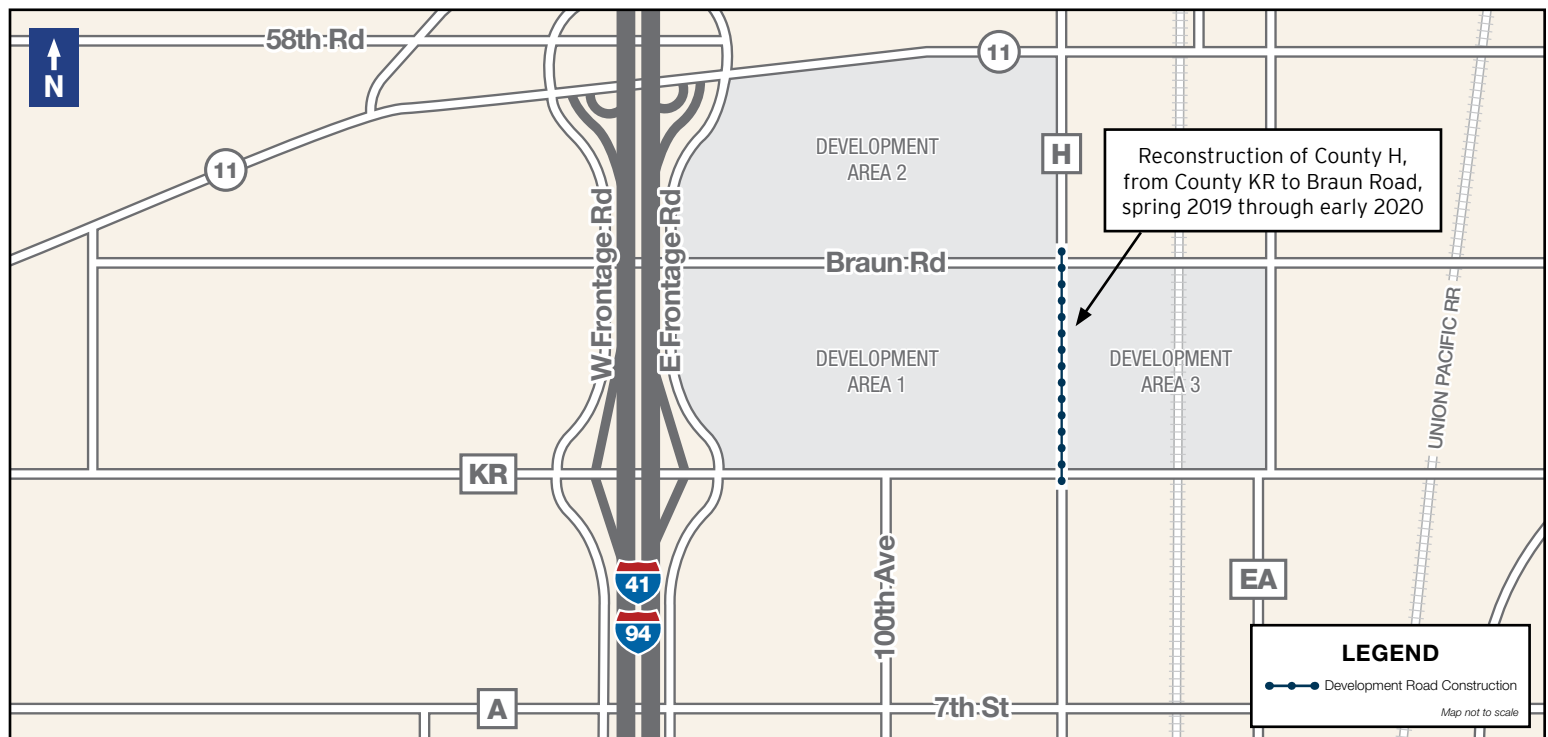
RECONSTRUCTION OF COUNTY H (COUNTY KR TO BRAUN ROAD)

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is currently reconstructing 16.5 miles of multi-lane roadways in and around the Wisconsin Valley Development. As part of this construction, County H, between County KR and Braun Road, is being reconstructed to a 4-lane concrete roadway. Highlights of the construction schedule are provided below.

COUNTY H

- Work began in spring 2019.
- Bidirectional traffic will be maintained during construction, with the exception a 13 day closure which was completed in spring 2019.
- Braun Road, between County H and 90th Street, will be closed until late 2019.
- County KR, east of County H, will be closed from spring to mid-summer 2019.
- County KR, west of County H will be closed for 21 days in mid-summer 2019.
- The following work is scheduled to take place in 2019:
 - > Reconstruct and widen County H roadway between County KR and Braun Road
 - > Reconstruct County H/County KR and County H/Braun Road intersections
- The following work is scheduled to take place in 2020:
 - > Project restoration
 - > Permanent signal installation

All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
