



PROJECT UPDATE

I-794 Lake Freeway/Hoan Bridge Project Information

As part of the I-794 Lake Freeway/Hoan Bridge Project, work continues to rebuild I-794 East. Nightly deck pours have begun on the new steel bridges between the Milwaukee River and Milwaukee Street, and will continue for the next month. Crews are using High Performance Concrete (HPC) which needs to be placed during nighttime hours when temperatures are lower and the concrete surface will not be dried out by the sun. This differs from standard concrete in that HPC used in bridge decks is more sensitive to factors such as sunlight, wind, and temperatures during initial placement. Completing the work at night ensures the highest quality product, thereby attaining the desired life span of the new bridge deck.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

These nighttime construction activities will create noise and require the use of additional lighting. Noise generated by concrete conveyors and pumps, as well as back up alarms on concrete trucks may be heard during the deck pour activities. Be assured that we always work hard to minimize the impact of these events, but, if you have a concern, please do not hesitate to contact us.
