



FROM THE NORTH:


1. I-43 South to McKinley/Fond du Lac Avenue exit. Left (east) on McKinley Avenue to Water Street. Right (south) on Water Street.
2. I-43 South to 11th Street/Highland Avenue exit. Continue straight (south) on 11th Street to Wisconsin Avenue. Left (east) on Wisconsin Avenue to Water Street. Right (south) on Water Street.
3. I-43 South to I-794 East. East on I-794 to Plankinton Avenue exit. Continue straight (north) on Plankinton Avenue.
4. I-43 South to National Avenue exit. Right (north) on 9th Street to National Avenue. Right (east) on National Avenue to 1st Street. Left (north) on 1st Street to Pittsburgh Avenue. Right (east) on Pittsburgh Avenue to Young Street.

TO THE NORTH:

1. West on Young Street to Pittsburgh Avenue. Continue straight (west) on Pittsburgh Avenue to 1st Street. Left (south) on 1st Street to Mineral Street. Right (west) on Mineral Street to I-43 North.*
2. North on Water Street to Knapp Street. Left (south) on Knapp Street to McKinley Avenue. Continue straight (west) on McKinley Avenue to I-43 North.*
3. West on Michigan Street to 2nd Street. Left (south) on 2nd Street to I-43 North.**
4. East on Michigan Street to Lincoln Memorial Drive. Right (south) on Lincoln Memorial Drive to I-794 West. West on I-794 to I-43 North.**

DIRECTIONS TO/FROM THE SOUTH



FROM THE SOUTH:


1. I-43 North to Becher Street exit. Right (east) on Becher Street to Kinnickinnic Avenue. Left (north) on Kinnickinnic Avenue to 1st Street. Right (north/east) on 1st Street to Pittsburgh Avenue. Right (east) on Pittsburgh Avenue to Young Street.
2. I-43 North to National Avenue exit. Right (north) on 9th Street to National Avenue. Right (east) on National Avenue to 1st Street. Left (north) on 1st Street to Pittsburgh Avenue. Right (east) on Pittsburgh Avenue to Young Street.

TO THE SOUTH:

1. West on Young Street to Pittsburgh Avenue. Continue straight (west) on Pittsburgh Avenue to 1st Street. Left (south) on 1st Street to Becher Street. Right (west) on Becher Street to I-43 South.*
2. East on Michigan Street to Lincoln Memorial Drive. Right (south) on Lincoln Memorial Drive to I-794 West. West on I-794 to I-43 South.**
3. West on Clybourn Street to I-43 South at 2nd Street.**
4. West on Wisconsin Avenue to 11th Street. Left (south) on 11th Street to I-43 South.**

ZOO INTERCHANGE PROJECT IMPACTS



ZOO INTERCHANGE PROJECT OVERVIEW

Work continues on the Zoo Interchange project which includes reconstruction of Eastbound and Westbound I-94 from 70th Street to the Zoo Interchange, US 45 from the Zoo Interchange to Swan Boulevard, the Wisconsin Avenue Bridge over US 45, and some of the system ramps in the core of the interchange. The map above illustrates the current closures located throughout the Zoo Interchange project.


SYSTEM RAMP CLOSURES

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the I-94 West to I-894/US 45 South system ramp and the I-894/US 45 North to I-94 West system ramp closed in early March. To facilitate the construction of the new interchange, the westbound to southbound system ramp (E-S) will remain closed until fall 2017. The northbound to westbound (S-W) system ramp will remain closed until late 2015.

During these closures, motorists are encouraged to utilize regional alternate routes when possible, in addition to the local alternate routes. The suggested alternate routes can be found to the right.

WESTBOUND TO SOUTHBOUND SYSTEM RAMP

Local Alternate Routes

- I-94 West to WIS 100 south to Greenfield Avenue east to I-894
- I-94 West to Miller Park Way south to Lincoln Avenue west to Beloit Road south/west to I-894

Regional Alternate Route

- I-43/I-94 South to I-43/I-894 West



NORTHBOUND TO WESTBOUND SYSTEM RAMP

Local Alternate Routes

- I-894 West (NB) to Greenfield Avenue west to WIS 100 north to I-94 West
- US 45 North to Watertown Plank Road west to WIS 100 south to I-94 West

Regional Alternate Routes

- I-43/I-94 North to I-94 West
- I-43 South to Moorland Road north to I-94 West

TRANSPORTATION OPTIONS

AMTRAK

Coming to Summerfest from Chicago or Racine/Kenosha? This summer, jam without traffic by taking the train with Amtrak Hiawatha Service between Chicago and Milwaukee. Amtrak Hiawatha offers easy access to Summerfest from the downtown Milwaukee Intermodal Station. You can catch the train from Chicago Union Station, Glenview in the Northern suburbs and Sturtevant in the Racine/Kenosha Area. Visit amtrakhiawatha.com for details.

FREEWAY FLYER SERVICE

Catch a Milwaukee County Transit System Freeway Flyer to Summerfest's Mid Gate from a park & ride lot where parking is free. Service begins one half-hour before and ends one half-hour after Summerfest ends. Visit ridemcts.com for details.

DOWNTOWN SHUTTLE SERVICE

Remember the Downtown Shuttle is a great way to avoid getting caught in a traffic jam. Park for less away from the fest, Shuttle in, Shuttle out, and easily escape the crowds near the festival grounds. Visit ridemcts.com for details. OZAUKEE COUNTY EXPRESS

Ozaukee County Express provides service from 11:30 am to 12:30 am daily, starting at the Saukville Wal-Mart (Hwy 33/Green Bay Avenue). The bus departs 13 minutes later from the Target/Home Depot (Hwy 60) in Grafton.

WAUKESHA SERVICE

The Wisconsin Coach Line shuttle originates from the Nagawaukee Park & Ride in Delafield (I-94/Hwy 83). Other pick-ups include the Meadowbrook Park & Ride lot (I-94/County Hwy G) and Goerke's Corners Park & Ride lot (I-94/Barker Road). The shuttle drop-off and pick-up at Summerfest is located west of the Mid Gate on Chicago Street. Visit wisconsincoach.com for details.

RACINE & KENOSHA SERVICE

Wisconsin Coach Lines will offer 8 northbound and southbound weekday trips and 4 weekend trips per day, as part of their regular service to serve Racine and Kenosha Summerfest attendees. Visit wisconsincoach.com for details.

MADISON SERVICE

Badger Bus will offer special service from Madison to Summerfest 5 times a day during the festival. The bus will drop off at the Wisconsin Coach stop at East Michigan Street and Jackson Street, four blocks from the Summerfest North Gate. Visit badgerbus.com for details.

GO RITWAY SUMMERFEST SHUTTLE

Park your car, it's FREE, then relax and ride GO Riteway's shuttle to Summerfest from two convenient locations in Washington County; the Washington County Fair Park (Highway 45/Pleasant Valley Road) and the Life Church parking lot (Mequon Road/Squire Drive). GO Riteway's shuttle drop-off and pick-up location at Summerfest is the North Gate. Visit goriteway.com for details.

PARKING INFORMATION

SUMMERFEST PARKING LOTS

Summerfest parking lots open daily at 9:00 a.m. Preferred Parking is only \$20 and Exclusive Parking is only \$35. All parking is on a first-come, first-served basis. Pre-paid parking passes for specific dates during Summerfest may be purchased online, at the Summerfest Box Office and via phone.

Free motorcycle parking is located near the Mid Gate, sponsored by Harley-Davidson®, on a first-come, first-served basis.

STATE FAIR PARK & RIDE


The State Fair Park & Ride is available to motorists that wish to park outside of downtown. Access to and from the parking lot is described in the map below. For other Park & Ride lots in the area, visit dot.wisconsin.gov/travel/parkride.

To the State Fair Park & Ride:

- *From the North:* US 45 South to I-94 East. East on I-94 to 84th Street exit. Right (south) on 84th Street to Adler Street/Main Street. Left (east) on Adler Street/Main Street to the State Fair Park & Ride on the left.
- *From the South:* I-894 West (northbound) to I-94 East. East on I-94 to 84th Street exit. Right (south) on 84th Street to Adler Street/Main Street. Left (east) on Adler Street/Main Street to the State Fair Park & Ride on the left.
- *From the West:* I-94 East to 84th Street exit. Right (south) on 84th Street to Adler Street/Main Street. Left (east) on Adler Street/Main Street to the State Fair Park & Ride on the left.
- *From the East:* I-94 West to 68th Street exit. Continue west on O'Connor Street to 76th Street. Left (south) on 76th Street to Adler Street/Main Street. Right (west) to the State Fair Park & Ride on the right.

From the State Fair Park & Ride:

- *To the North:* East on Adler Street/Main Street to 70th Street. Left (north) on 70th Street to I-94 West entrance on the left. West on I-94 to US 45 North. **OR** West on Adler Street/Main Street to 84th Street. Right (north) on 84th Street to I-94 West entrance on the left. West on I-94 to US 45 North. **Please see posted signs for open ramp*
- *To the South:* East on Adler Street/Main Street to 76th Street. Right (south) on 76th Street to Greenfield Avenue. Right (west) on Greenfield Avenue to I-894 East (southbound) entrance on the left.
- *To the West:* East on Adler Street/Main Street to 70th Street. Left (north) on 70th Street to I-94 West entrance on the left. **OR** West on Adler Street/Main Street to 84th Street. Right (north) on 84th Street to I-94 West entrance on the left. **Please see posted signs for open ramp*
- *To the East:* East on Adler Street/Main Street to 70th Street. Left (north) on 70th Street to Kearney Street. Right (east) on Kearney Street to I-94 East entrance ahead.
