Interstate improvements

- Reconstruct and expand 45 miles of I-39/90 from four to six lanes.
- Reconfigure 11 interchanges.
- Replace nearly 100 bridges.
- Expand from four to eight lanes from WIS 11 (Avalon Rd.) to the WIS 26 interchange in Janesville.








Central Segment improvements

- Eight lanes County O to WIS 26
- Six lanes WIS 26 to Dane/Rock Co. Line
- Collector/Distributor lanes at US 14 and WIS 26 interchanges
- Bridges reconstructed
- Bicycle and pedestrian accommodations
- US 14/US 51 alternate route
- Noise barriers
- Construction 2015 through 2022








South Segment improvements


- 12 miles from Illinois state line to County O
 - Six lanes from Illinois state line to WIS 11 (Avalon Road)
 - Eight lanes from WIS 11 to County O
- Interchanges reconstructed
- Roadway deficiencies addressed
- To be completed in 2022







I-39/90 expansion - 2017-2020




- 12-mile stretch from Hart Road near Beloit to US 14 interchange
- Interstate to be reconstructed and expanded
- Alternate routes available
- This section of work to be completed by 2020





I-39/90 traffic configuration during construction

- Two lanes open in each direction on I-39/90, separated by a temporary median barrier wall.
- Periodic nighttime ramp closures at I-39/90 and WIS 11/Racine Street interchange.
- Crossovers for northbound traffic to occur near Racine Street in fall 2017, and move south to Hart Road in spring 2018.
- All I-39/90 northbound traffic to return to original lanes at US 14 interchange in Janesville.








Construction Staging: September – mid-October 2017

Nighttime only










Construction Staging: Mid-October 2017 – Fall 2018

*In spring 2018, northbound crossover to occur at Hart Road near Beloit








Construction Staging: Fall 2018 – Spring 2019

I-39/90 from Hart Road near Beloit north to US 14 (Humes Road) interchange








Construction Staging: Spring 2019 – Fall 2019

I-39/90 from Hart Road near Beloit north to US 14 (Humes Road) interchange








Construction Staging: Fall 2019 – Spring 2020








Construction Staging: Summer 2019 – Summer 2020



- Attend public meetings to increase your knowledge of the project.
- Sign up for project email updates. Also provide names and emails for others within your organization!







Stay involved

- For any special concerns, coordinate and hold a pre-construction meeting with WisDOT and the contractor.
 - Find out the construction staging, etc.
 - Learn what to expect (i.e., dirt, mud, ground shaking, etc.)
- Participate in project update meetings.









- Get involved early. Advanced planning and organization pays off.
- Form an alliance with other businesses in your area.
 - Pool resources to purchase group advertising.
- Hold regular, frequent meetings with other businesses to share strategies and support.




