



I-39/90 Expansion, Beloit to Janesville

Know Before You Go

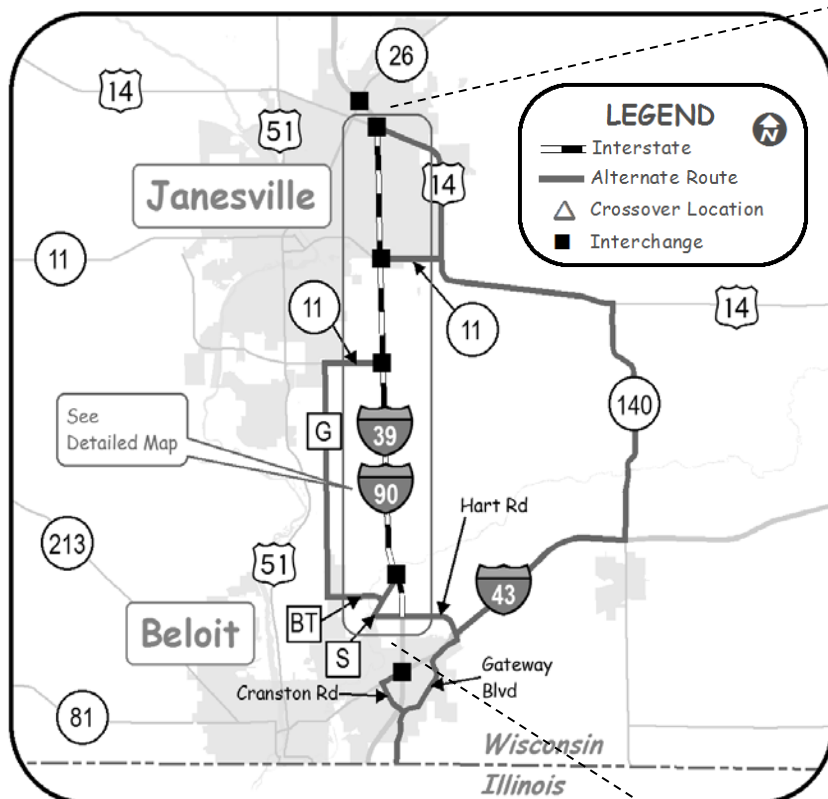
Starting in September, crews will reconstruct and expand a 12-mile stretch of Interstate 39/90 from Hart Road near Beloit, north to the I-39/90 and US 14 interchange (Exit 171B) in Janesville. Motorists will use a crossover north of the I-39/90 and WIS 11/Racine Street interchange (Exit 175) to move to the temporary northbound lanes, allowing Interstate traffic to be maintained on two lanes of travel in each direction. In spring 2018, the crossover will occur just south of the County S interchange (Exit 183).

Local roadways under I-39/90 in Janesville may be temporarily closed for bridge work during the Interstate expansion. These brief local road closures will be announced through area media and the I-39/90 project website (listed below). Periodic nighttime lane and ramp closures are also anticipated in the project limits.

The northbound Interstate, between Hart Road and the US 14 interchange, will be expanded in 2018 and I-39/90 southbound in this area will be reconstructed and expanded in 2019. During these activities, Interstate traffic will be located on the opposite side with two lanes open in each direction. Interstate expansion within these limits between Beloit and Janesville is scheduled to be completed in spring 2020.

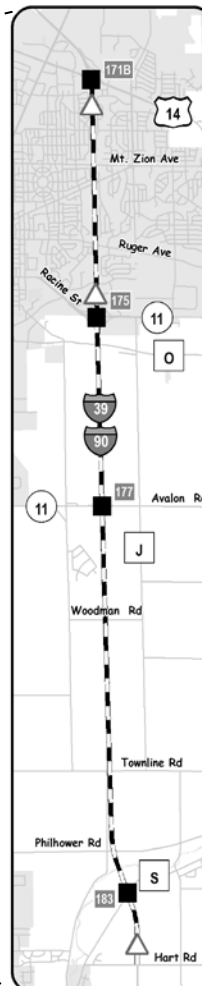

Alternate Routes

Alternate routes have been established on nearby county, state or US highways adjacent to I-39/90.

These highways are not detour routes, but provide an option to motorists to potentially avoid any delays due to incidents or congestion. In this area, motorists can use I-43 to WIS 140 and then US 14, east of I-39/90, or County S to County BT and County G west of the Interstate.
