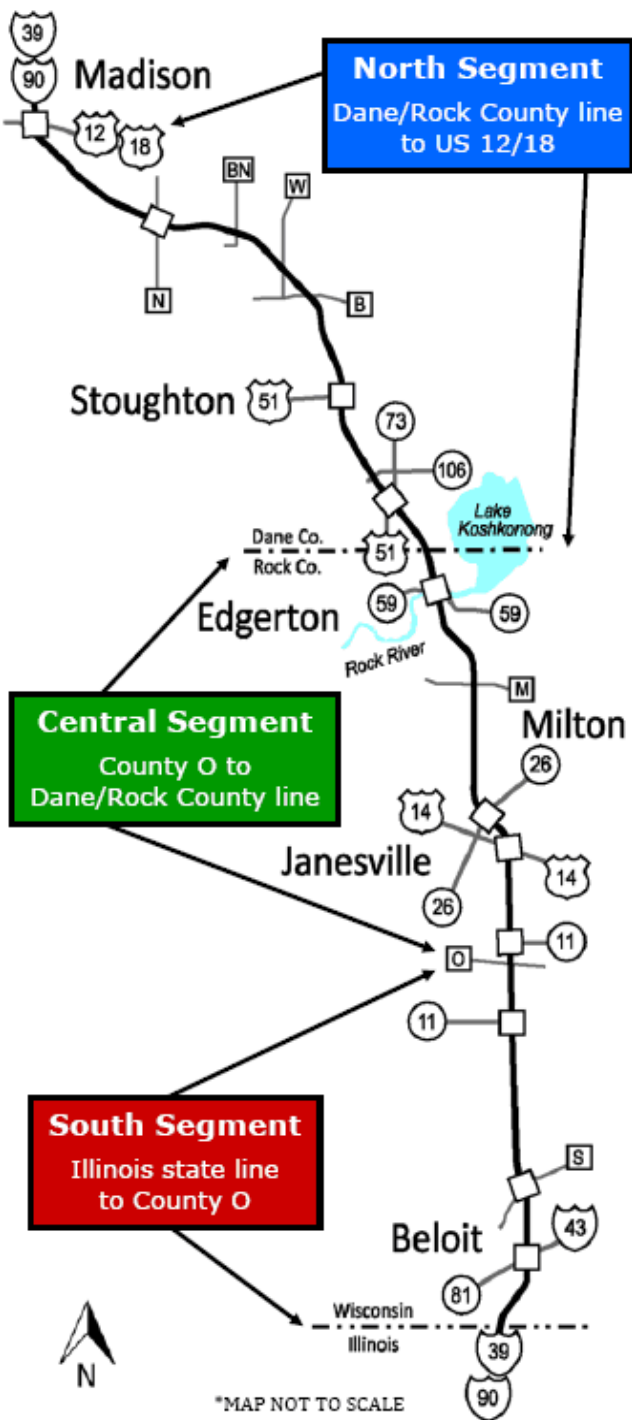
Interstate improvements

- Reconstruct and expand 45 miles of I-39/90 from four to six lanes.
- Reconfigure 11 interchanges.
- Replace nearly 100 bridges.
- Expand from four to eight lanes from WIS 11 (Avalon Rd.) to the WIS 26 interchange in Janesville.

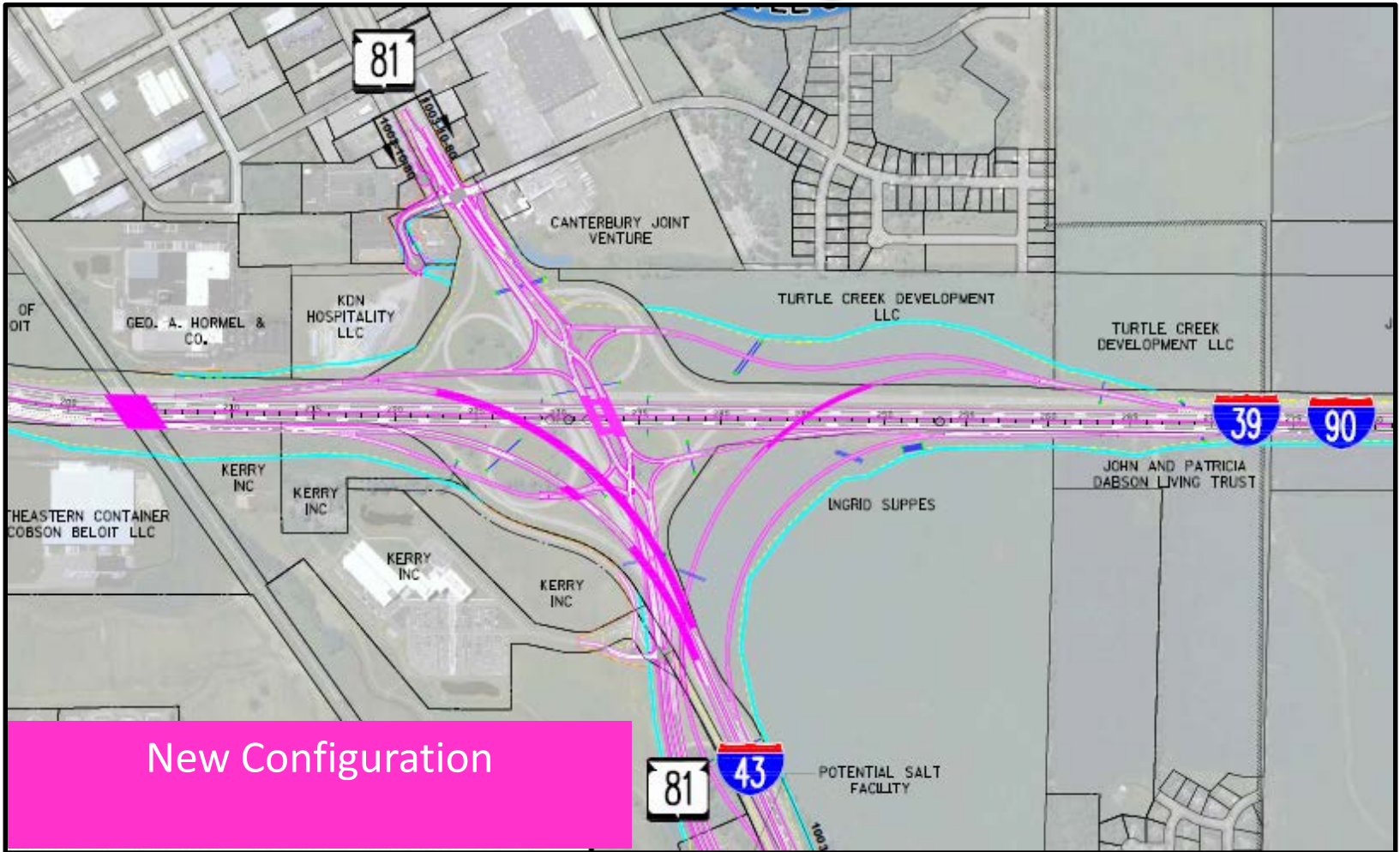


Project segments

- Design began in 2012
 - Three design teams
 - Corridor management at Edgerton project office
- Construction through 2022
 - Overpasses
 - Interchanges
 - Temporary widening
 - Mainline

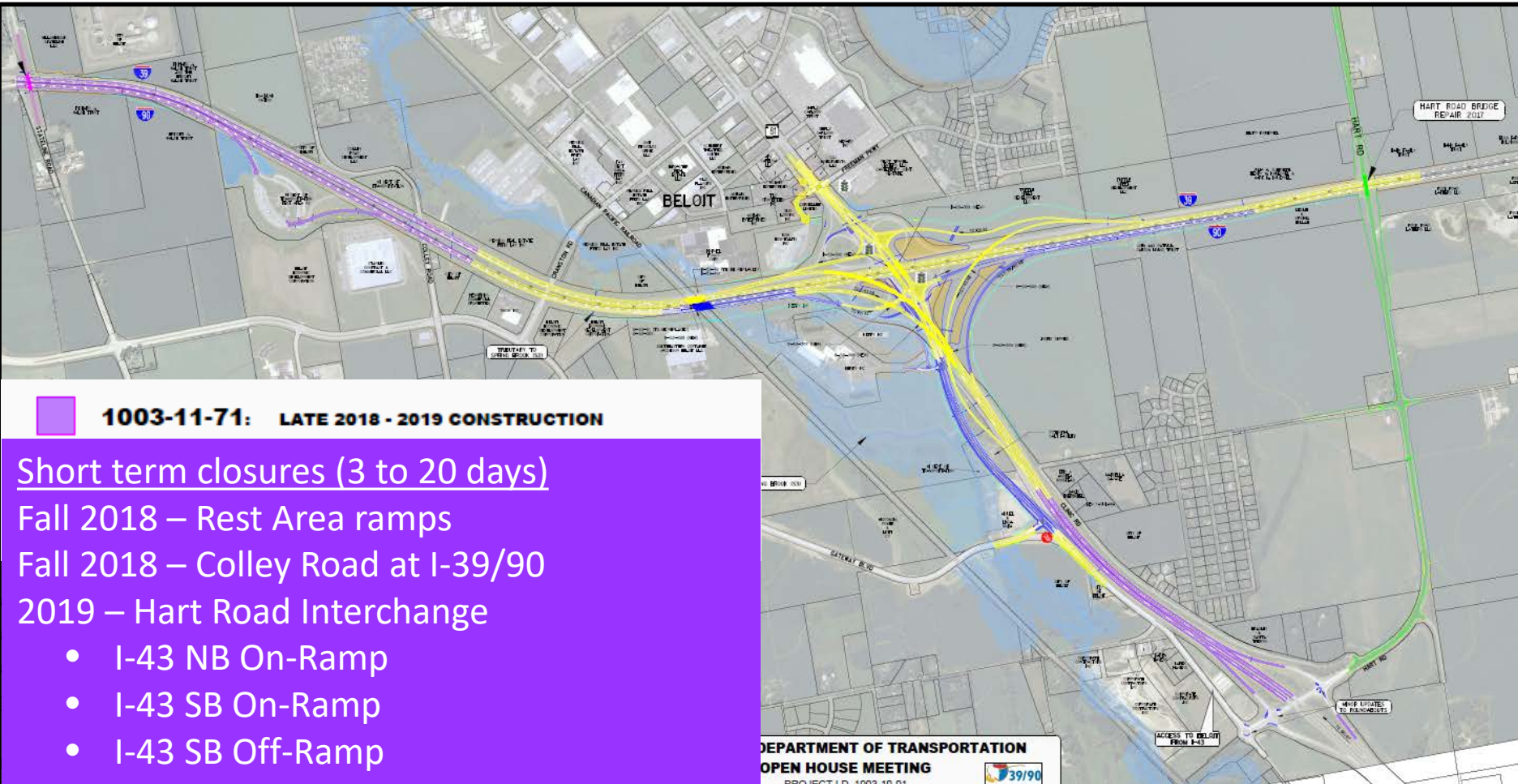
Construction staging:

- Three (3) construction projects
- Maintain two lanes in each direction on I-39/90
- Maintain one lane in each direction on I-43
- Limited ramp closures
- Short-term (3 to 20 days) and periodic nighttime closures
 - Detour routes for closures
- Notifications to traffic at least two weeks in advance of any closures
 - Also provided via media and project website

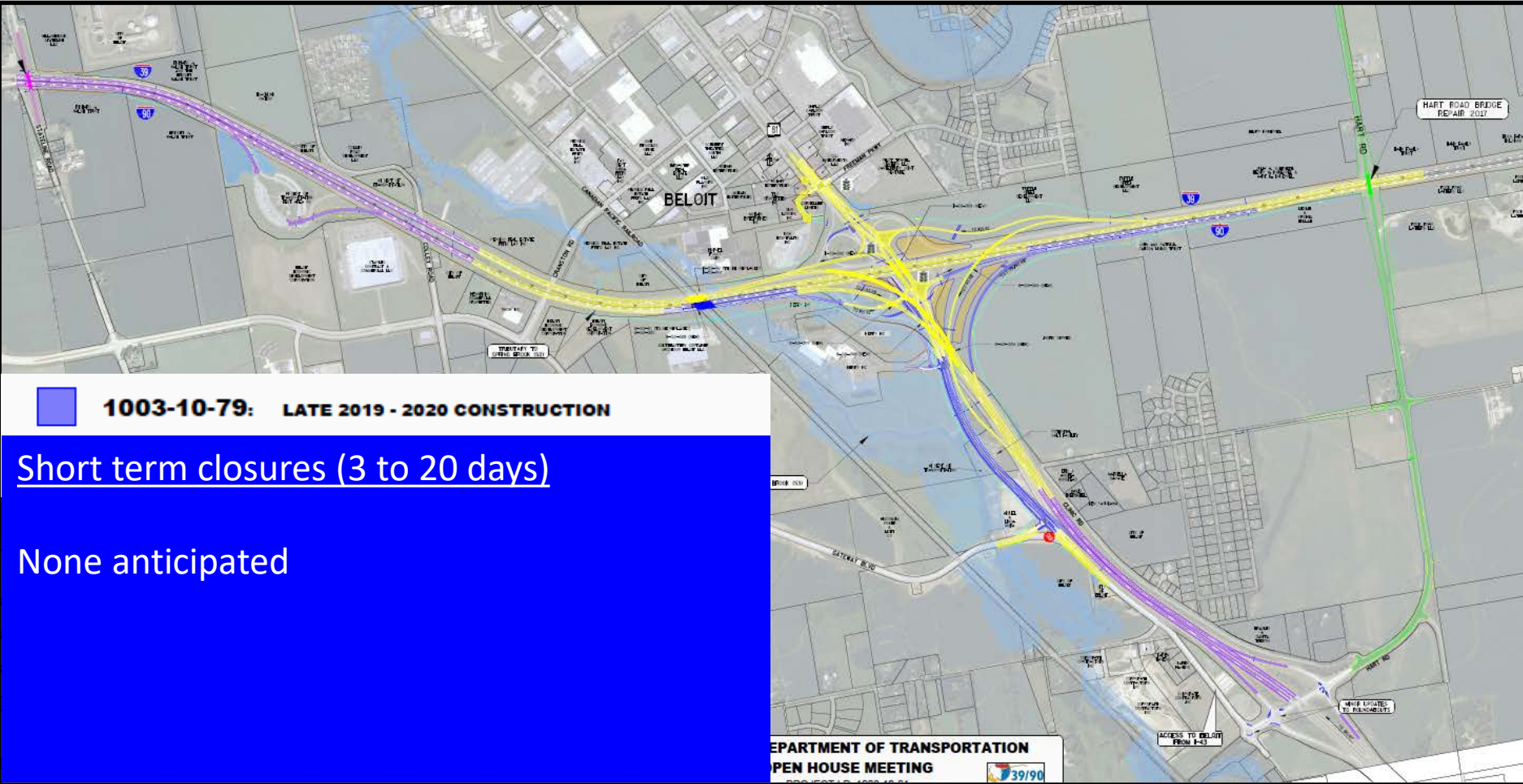




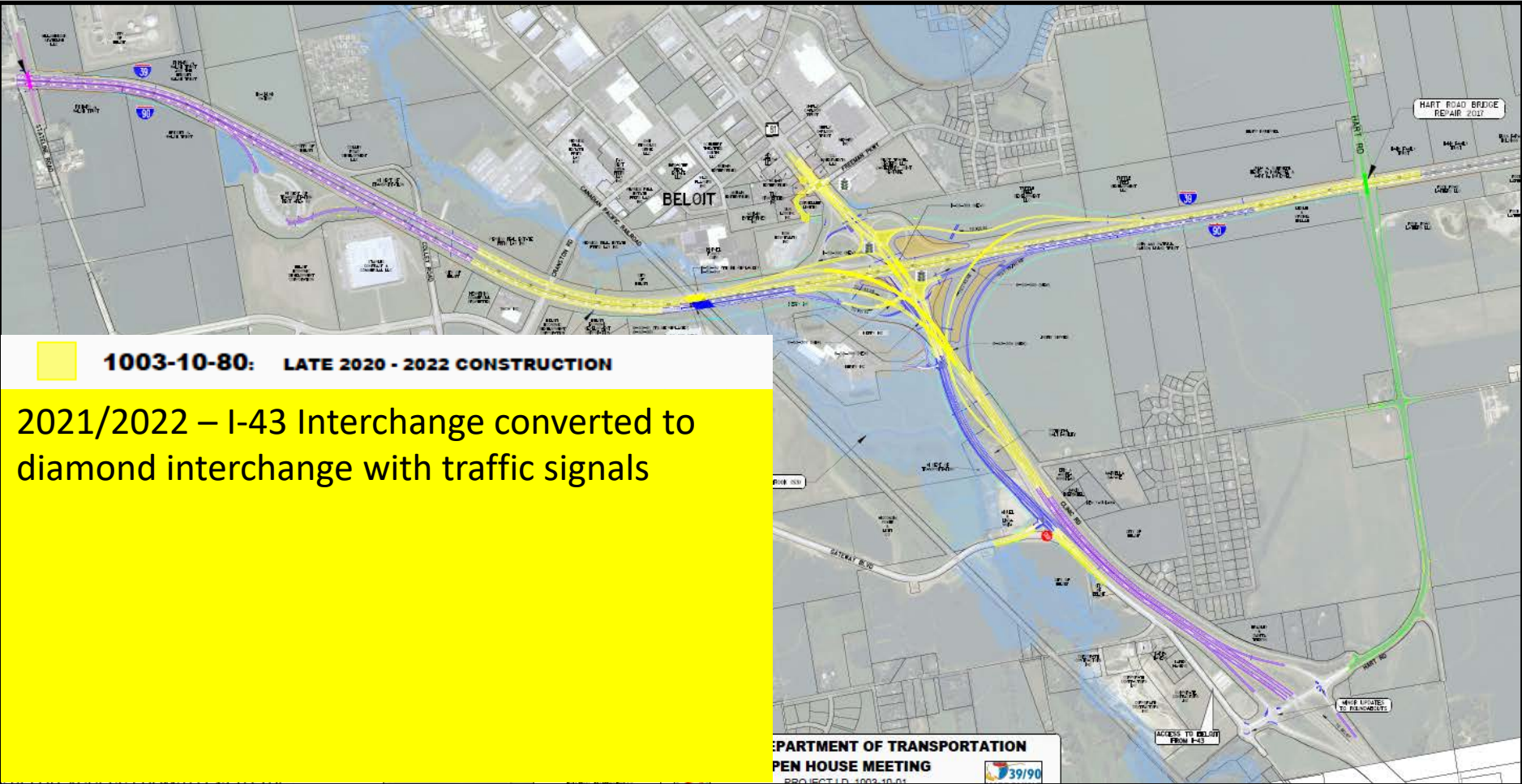
I-43 interchange: -71 Project

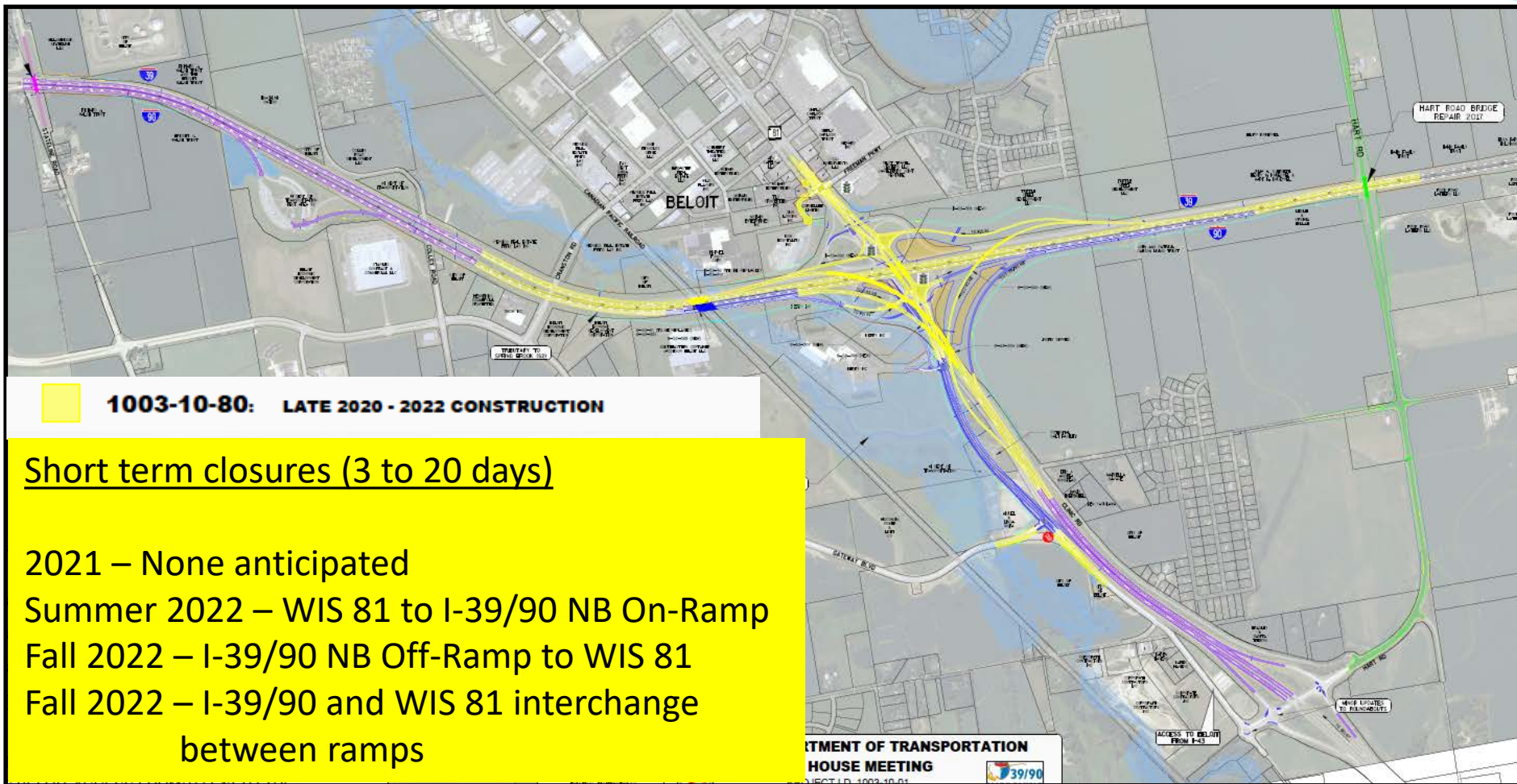

Diverging Diamond Interchange

DDIs constructed at the following I-39/90 interchanges:

- WIS 11 (Avalon Road), south of Janesville
completed in 2016
- WIS 26, in Janesville
scheduled to be open in 2021
- WIS 81, near Beloit
scheduled to be open in 2022

What is a DDI?

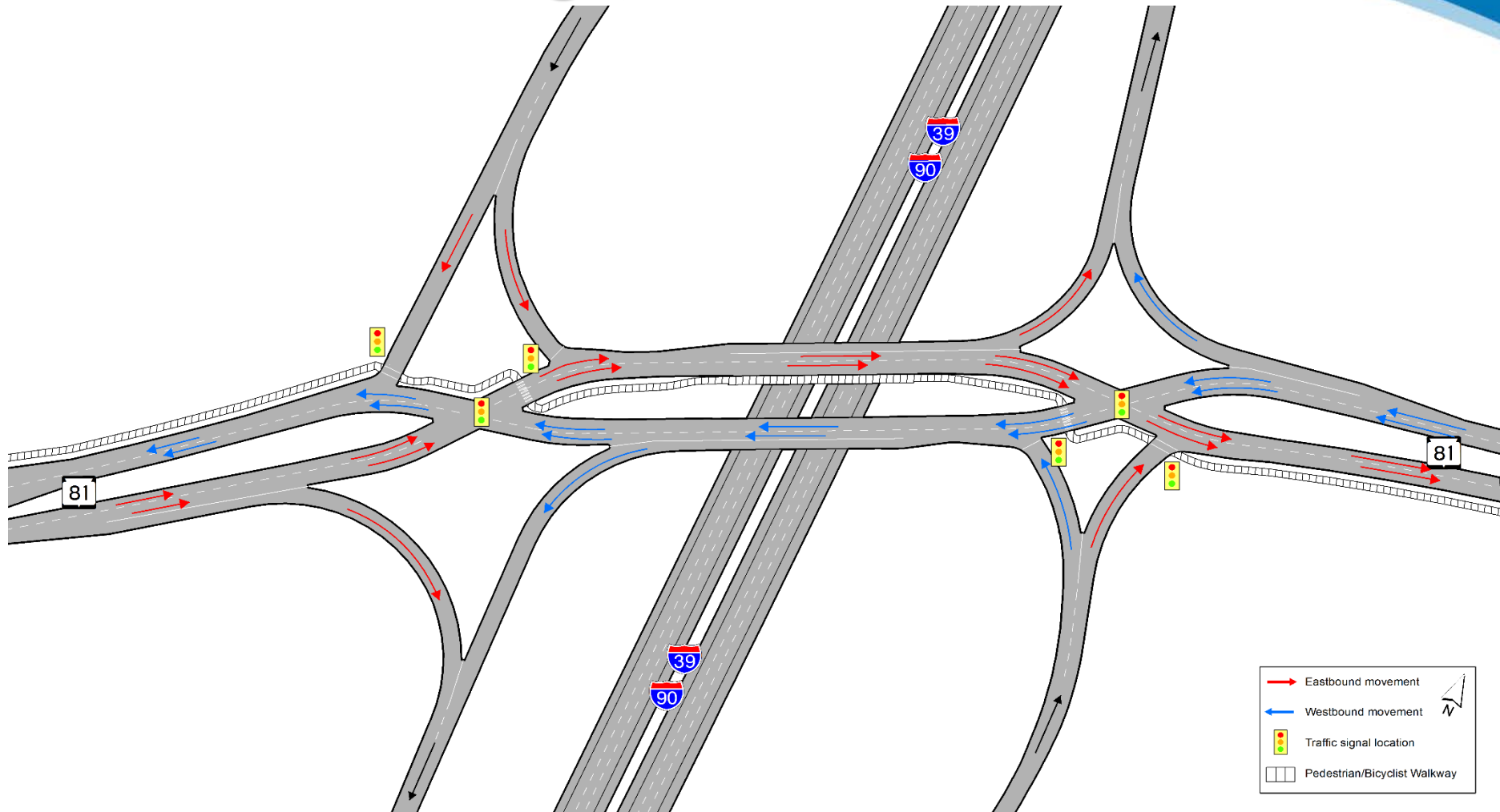
Interchange where traffic crosses over to the opposite side of the road, with traffic signals at the ramps, to create a free flow left turn movement onto the major highway.

Benefits of a DDI

- **Safety** – Reduces the number of conflict points (14 compared to 26 for a conventional diamond interchange).
- **Greater capacity and efficiency** – Accommodates more traffic than conventional designs. Free-flow left turns.
- **Easy navigation** – Guides drivers with overhead signs, pavement marking and traffic signals.
- **Reduces backup congestion** – DDIs reduce traffic backups because the free-flow left turns mean vehicles do not have to stop to access the ramp.
- **Meets the needs of all road users** – Accommodates large trucks, motorists, pedestrians and bicyclists.

Stay informed

- Meet the on-site project manager – keep his/her telephone number in a handy place.
- Attend public meetings to increase your knowledge of the project.
- **Sign up for project email updates.** Also provide names and emails for others within your organization!



Stay involved

- For any special concerns, coordinate and hold a pre-construction meeting with WisDOT and the contractor.
 - Find out the construction staging, etc.
 - Learn what to expect (i.e., dirt, mud, ground shaking, etc.)
- Participate in project update meetings.



Tips

- Get involved early. Advanced planning and organization pays off.
- Form an alliance with other businesses in your area.
 - Pool resources to purchase group advertising.
- Hold regular, frequent meetings with other businesses to share strategies and support.





Northbound Interstate ramp **CLOSED** to US 14 (Exit 171B).




