2015 construction season (South Segment) Wrap Up

- I-39/90 and County S (Shopiere Road) interchange, north of Beloit.
- County G (Prairie Avenue) and County BT (Inman Parkway extension), between Janesville and Beloit.
 - o County G expected to reopen in mid-December 2015.
- WIS 11 (Avalon Road) interchange, south of Janesville.
 - o Work will continue over the winter months with anticipated completion in November 2016.

2016 construction projects scheduled

(South Segment)

- Rehabilitation of the I-39/90 southbound bridge over Turtle Creek, near the County S (Shopiere Road) interchange.
- Improvements to the US 14 and WIS 140 intersection, north of Avalon, including safety enhancements to WIS 140, which is a designated alternate route.
- Alternate route improvements to Hart Road, between I-43 and County S Shopiere Road), near Beloit.

2016 construction projects scheduled

(South/Central Segment)

• Temporary widening of I-39/90 southbound from just north of the WIS 26 interchange in Janesville south to the WIS 11 (Avalon Road) interchange.

- There have been three TrANS classes held in Southwestern Wisconsin: October 2014 (Rock County); March 2015 (Dane County), June 2015 (Rock County).
- There have been 25 placements of Rock County TrANS graduates, 9 have been hired by Rock Roads.
- The next Southwestern TrANS class will start on December 15th in Dane County.
- The next Rock County TrANS class will start in March 2016.

- Of the 11 TrANS graduates hired, 2 were sponsored into the Wisconsin Operators Union.
- Of the 11 TrANS graduates hired, 9 are Laborers.
- Total TrANS graduate hours on the 9 projects worked this summer: 3,093.50
- 1.47% of all hours worked by all employees on 9 projects (Not all projects were Mega)
- Only 644.5 of the 3,093.50 hours was on ASP 1 projects. 2,449 hours used by contractors were without reimbursement
- 330 TrANS graduate hours were used on other Rock Road projects
