


2016 Construction and Traffic Impacts



2016 Construction and Traffic Impacts

2016 construction will include the eastbound lanes of I-90 from Round Lake to Theater Road, the eastbound I-90 bridges over US 53/Rose Street and the French Slough, the rest area exit ramp bridge, the County B bridge over I-90, WIS 35 from the railroad to Elm Street, the southbound WIS 35 bridge over the railroad, ramp gate installations at County B, WIS 157, and WIS 16 interchanges, and the rest area. Anticipated impacts to traffic during construction include:

- All roadways remain open except as noted below
- I-90 reduced to one lane in each direction from Round Lake to US 53/Rose Street and a portion of I-90 under WIS 157
- WIS 35 reduced to one lane in each direction from the railroad to north project limits
- County B remains open during construction
- Short term ramp closures for nighttime traffic control operations are allowed
- Eastbound I-90 loop ramp to northbound US 53/Rose Street closed most of the summer, detoured through the WIS 157 interchange
- Northbound WIS 157 to westbound I-90 and southbound WIS 157 to eastbound I-90 loop ramps will be closed and detoured for the majority of the construction season
- WIS 35 sidewalk and bike route closed and detoured from Oak Forest Drive to Elm Street
- Brief stops (up to 15 minutes) on I-90 and US 53 for bridge and/or sign structure placement or removal to occur Monday through Thursday 12 a.m. to 4 a.m.
- Potential lane closures on US 53/Rose Street during periods of low traffic volumes for work on the I-90 bridge
- Rest area will be closed for the duration of the project
- Short term closures in one direction at a time allowed along USH 53/Rose Street Monday – Friday 12 a.m. to 4 a.m.
