- The \$1.9 billion project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges

WIS 20 Interchange Reconstruction Project Update

As part of Wisconsin Department of Transportation's (WisDOT) WIS 20 Interchange reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled.

Following the 2015 pavement inspection by WisDOT, specific areas were identified as needing repair.

Scheduled closures are required to complete the repair work prior to WisDOT's acceptance of project completion.

Three lanes of traffic will be maintained on I-94 EAST (SB).

Tuesday, September 13, 2016:

- I-94 EAST (SB) entrance ramp from WIS 20 is scheduled to close long-term to traffic late Tuesday evening, September 13, and is scheduled to reopen late September.

Detour:

→ Traffic on WIS 20 will be directed to use West Frontage Road southbound to WIS 11 to access I-94 EAST (SB).
