I-94 North-South Frontage Roads Project Update

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is scheduled to begin reconstruction of the east and west frontage roads as part of the I-94 North-South Freeway Project.

Schedule:

Starting January 8, 2018, with scheduled completion June 2018.

Overview:

- Reconstruct the frontage roads and intersections with cross streets.
- Reconstruct 6.5 miles of the frontage roads.
- Widen shoulders to improve safety.

What to expect:

- During construction, both east and west frontage roads will be open to local traffic only.
- County KR, WIS 11 and WIS 20 will remain open to traffic throughout the duration of the project. This also includes interchange access to I-94 North-South.
- The park and ride lot at WIS 11 is expected to remain open.
- I-94 North-South via County KR, WIS 11 or WIS 20 interchanges are the recommended detour routes to get around the closures.
