

Access Changes at 27th Street to Occur

As part of Wisconsin Department of Transportation's (WisDOT) I-94 North-South Freeway reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project.

Monday, October 15, 2018:

- 27th Street entrance/exit ramps at I-94 to close to traffic permanently on Monday by 6 a.m.
 - A new interchange will be constructed a half mile north of the existing 27th Street interchange at Elm Road and is scheduled to open to traffic December 2019 (with short-term ramp closures spring 2020).
- West Frontage Road, at 27th Street, is scheduled to close to traffic long-term for three weeks beginning Monday by 6 a.m.
 - 27th Street will be reconstructed and will feature a new free flow connection with West Frontage Road.

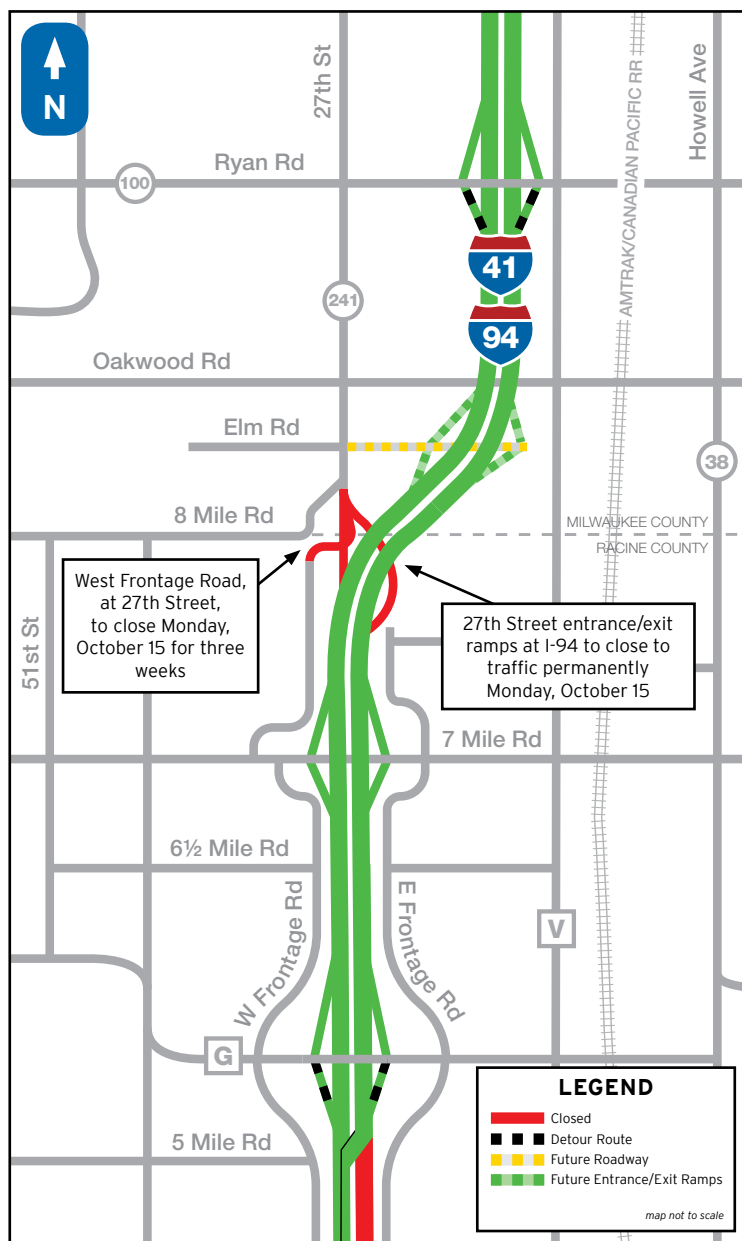
Detour route:

- › Travelers can utilize the I-94 EAST (SB) entrance ramps at Ryan Road or County G and the I-94 WEST (NB) exit ramps to Ryan Road or County G to get around the closures.

Please note that all closures are weather dependent and subject to change.
