I-94 North-South Freeway Project information

I-94 North-South (North Segment)

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is currently reconstructing I-94 North-South from County G north to College Avenue (North Segment).

Overview:

- Expand freeway to four lanes in each direction with safety and operational improvements
- · Replace all existing bridges
- 7.5 miles of freeway reconstruction
- Reconstruct Seven Mile Road interchange
- Construct new interchange at Elm Road
- Permanent closure of 27th Street ramps

Construction schedule:

2018: Reconstruct Ryan Road interchange 2018 - Summer 2019: Reconstruct I-94 EAST (SB) lanes Summer - Late 2019: Reconstruct I-94 WEST (NB) lanes 2020: Median work between Ryan Road and College Avenue, reconstruct Seven Mile Road and Oakwood Road crossroads

Three lanes of traffic will remain open in each direction. Four lanes of traffic in each direction are scheduled to open by June 2020. The speed limit in the work zone is reduced to 60 mph.
