ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.

Ryan Road Construction Update

As part of the Ryan Road Interchange Reconstruction Project, a traffic switch, on Ryan Road, is scheduled to take place mid June.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- As a result of this switch, all lanes of traffic, between 13th Street and 22nd Street, will be placed on the new westbound lanes of Ryan Road, where it will remain until fall 2018. A single lane will remain open in both directions. Access to all ramps will be maintained.
- Overnight full freeway closures are scheduled in late June for demolition of the south half of the Ryan Road bridge over I-94 North and South. Traffic will utilize the entrance and exit ramps at Ryan Road as a detour. Ryan Road, over I-94, will be closed during the demolition.
- The Park and Ride lot located at Ryan Road and I-94 is anticipated to reopen in fall 2018.
