

## Project<sub>BRIEE</sub>

*I-94 North-South Freeway Project information* 

## ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Stretches 35 miles between the Mitchell Interchange in Milwaukee, through Racine and Kenosha counties to the Illinois state line.
- The project will expand the interstate to four lanes in each direction and redesign 17 interchanges.
- Construction began in 2009 and will be complete in 2021.

## **Ryan Road Construction Update**

As part of the I-94 North/South Project the Ryan Road Interchange will be reconstructed. Work is scheduled to begin in late October.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

Late October to early December 2017

- Single lane closures on Ryan Road from 22nd Street to just west of 13th Street to construct crossovers, install temporary lighting/signals, and temporary drainage. Overnight closures of the northbound and southbound exit ramps to Ryan Road are also anticipated during this period.
- The Park and Ride lot located at Ryan Road and I-94 will close December 3 and is anticipated to reopen in fall 2018.

Early to mid-December through fall 2018

- Double lane closures on Ryan Road from 27th Street to just east of 13th Street and reduced ramp turn bays to prepare for demolition and construction of the north half of the Ryan Road bridge over I-94. A single lane will remain open for eastbound and westbound Ryan Road. Access to all ramps will be maintained.
- Overnight full freeway closures will be utilized in December for demolition of the Ryan Road Bridge over I-94 North and South. Traffic will utilize the entrance and exit ramps at Ryan Road as a detour.

The project will remain in the static single lane phase until early fall 2018.
