

The number of families within the corridor is estimated by utilizing the Census 2000 population counts. The population count for the Census Block Group is converted into a population density based on the *SEWRPC Regional Land Use Inventory 2000* for each Census Block Group. The estimated population is then computed based on the amount of residential land within the I-94 corridor. The number of families is then estimated by using the ratio of the population within the corridor.

\*The Census defines a Family Household as "a householder and one or more people living in the same household who are related to the householder by birth, marriage, or adoption."

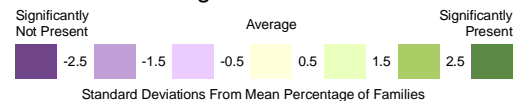
