
## Roadways/Ramps Open

- I-794 East exit ramp to Lincoln Memorial Dr.
- I-794 West exit ramp to Lincoln Memorial Dr.
- Lincoln Memorial Dr. entrance ramp to I-794 West
- Lincoln Memorial Dr. entrance ramp to I-794 East (SB)
- Harbor Dr., Polk St. to Michigan St.
- Chicago St., Jackson St. to Harbor Dr.

## West Detours (I-794 to/from Lincoln Memorial Dr.)




### To West

1. South on Lincoln Memorial Dr. to Michigan St.
2. Right (west) on Michigan St. to Jackson St.
3. Left (south) on Jackson St.
4. Enter I-794 West using the entrance ramp on the right.

### From West

1. I-794 East to the Jackson/Van Buren St. exit.
2. Continue north on Van Buren St. to Michigan St.
3. Right (east) on Michigan St. to Lincoln Memorial Dr.

## South Detours (I-794 to/from Lincoln Memorial Dr.)




### From South (also see page 2)

1. I-794 West to the Milwaukee St. exit.
2. Continue north on Milwaukee St. to Michigan St.
3. Right (east) on Michigan St. to Lincoln Memorial Dr.

### To South (also see page 2)

1. South on Lincoln Memorial Dr. to Michigan St.
2. Right (west) on Michigan St. to Broadway.
3. Left (south) on Broadway.
4. Enter I-794 East using the entrance ramp on the left.
