## Harbor Drive & Chicago Street Closure Planned for January 18

Construction is starting on the new Lincoln Memorial Drive extension requiring the long-term closures of Harbor Drive between Michigan Street and Polk Street and of Chicago Street between Jackson Street and Harbor Drive. The construction will require detours for the Oak Leaf and Hank Aaron trails.

### Harbor Drive Closure / Michigan Street to Polk Street

Harbor Drive will be closed to traffic between Michigan Street and Polk Street. **Southbound traffic** will use Michigan Street to Jackson Street; left on Jackson Street to Corcoran Street; right on Corcoran Street to Jefferson Street; left on Jefferson Street to Erie Street; left on Erie Street to Polk Street; left on Polk Street; continue on Polk Street to Harbor Drive.

**Northbound traffic** will use Polk Street to Erie Street; right on Erie Street to Jefferson Street; right on Jefferson Street to Corcoran Street; right on Corcoran Street to Jackson Street; left on Jackson Street to Buffalo Street; right on Buffalo Street to Van Buren Street; left on Van Buren Street to Michigan Street; right on Michigan Street; continue to the lakefront via Michigan Street.

### Chicago Street Closure: Jackson Street to Harbor Drive

Chicago Street will be closed to traffic between Jackson Street and Harbor Drive. Access to the CPS parking lot will be off of Van Buren Street.


### Oak Leaf Trail & Hank Aaron Trail Detour Routes – Effective January 18, 2016

The Hank Aaron and Oak Leaf trails will be closed between Michigan Street and Chicago Street, preventing access between the lakefront and the Third Ward. Detour signage will guide users along the “lake loop” of the Hank Aaron Trail through Lake Shore Park as illustrated on the diagram at right.
