

# **The Loop Trail**


### **Overview**

- Extends 4.7 miles around loop
- Accommodates bicycle and pedestrian traffic
- Connects to existing local and regional trails in Minnesota and Wisconsin
- To be constructed from 2015-2019 in phases. Trail sections and parking will be open for use after they are constructed
- Uses the existing Stillwater Lift Bridge, which will be converted to a bicycle/pedestrian/boat facility from 2017 thru summer 2019
- Uses a designated bicycle/pedestrian lane on the St. Croix Crossing



## **Minnesota Loop Trail Construction**

- Staged construction
- Phase 1: North of Sunnyside Marina to north of Nelson Street (blue trail below) – Completed in 2015-16
- Phase 2: Upper trail and Chestnut Street connection (pink trail below) -2018 Construction
  - Parking lot built north of north entrance to Sunnyside Marina (pink rectangle below)

### **Wisconsin Loop Trail Construction**

- Staged construction
- Phase 1: Pedestrian underpass Completed in 2015
- Phase 2: Paving of trail from pedestrian underpass to St. Croix Crossing – Completed in 2016
- Phase 3: Construction of Park and Ride lot and connecting trail – Initial construction fall 2017, completed May 2018
- Phase 4: Scheduled for 2018 (value) and purple trails) - Construction of:
  - Parking lots & trailheads, including all trail amenities
  - Landscaping, pavement marking and signage of entire Loop Trail
  - Reconfiguration of Highway

  - Reconfiguration of Main Street, Hilltop Drive and Old County Road E west of Main Street
