US 10/WIS 42 (Waldo Blvd.) reconstruction/roundabout project finishes tomorrow in the city of Manitowoc

Project complete on time and under budget

(Manitowoc) The Wisconsin Department of Transportation Northeast Region office announces completion of an urban reconstruction of US 10/WIS 42/Waldo Blvd. from 14th Street to Maritime Drive in the city of Manitowoc. Crews will open US 10 and remove all traffic control devices and detour signage by tomorrow, Friday evening, Nov. 8. Motorists may see some minor landscaping work still being conducted in the project limits.

The \$13.56 million project began April 8 and finishes on time and under budget. Final cost figures are still being tabulated by the project manager from the contractor, but early calculations put the project under budget by approximately 1% to 3% of the estimated \$13.56 million. Work on the west half of Waldo Blvd begins next year under a separate contract.

2019 urban reconstruction and roundabout project finished

- Urban reconstruction of US 10/WIS 42/Waldo Blvd. from 14th Street to Maritime Drive.
 - Four-lane roadway with wider shoulders, sidewalk replacement, water main, sanitary sewer, storm sewer and curb/gutter.
- Construction of a roundabout at the WIS 42 and Maritime Drive intersection.
- Realignment of the Menasha Avenue intersection.
- Signal replacement at the intersections of 11th Street, and 8th Street (County B).
- New lighting and pavement markings.

2020 construction

A separate project on the west half of US 10/Waldo Blvd. in the city of Manitowoc will take place in 2020 from 14th Street to County R in Manitowoc. The 2020 project includes reconstruction between 14th St. and Fleetwood Dr., resurfacing from Fleetwood Dr. to County R, a new bridge deck over the railroad tracks, a new box culvert and new traffic signals. The Waldo Blvd will again be closed during 2020 construction.
