Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Short-term closures scheduled for the weekend of Friday, August 18 through Monday, August 21, 2017.


Summit Avenue (HWY 18) from Meadowbrook Road (County TT) west to Torhorst Road is scheduled to close to traffic for storm sewer crossing.

 Summit Avenue is scheduled to close to traffic Friday, August 18 beginning at 7 p.m. and will remain closed through Monday, August 21 at 6 a.m. for storm sewer crossing.

Detour Route: Motorists are encouraged to use Meadowbrook Road south to Madison Street, west on Madison Street to County DT, and north on County DT to Summit Avenue to get around the closure. (See map for details.)

Please note there will be noise associated with the storm sewer crossing work and that steps are taken to minimize these effects.

We ask that travelers utilize the posted detour route and not detour through local subdivisions or on private roads to get around the closure.
