West Waukesha Bypass Project Update

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will continue the reconstruction of the West Waukesha Bypass, with work activities resuming mid-March. The project is scheduled to be complete in mid-summer.


Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Summit Avenue (US 18) traffic switch scheduled Friday night, March 23, 2018:

• Summit Avenue eastbound traffic just east and west of Meadowbrook Road is scheduled to be shifted to the westbound lanes while crews reconstruct the eastbound lanes east and west of Meadowbrook. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. The traffic switch is scheduled to take place during the nighttime hours Friday evening.

Work scheduled to begin on Meadowbrook Road (County TT) early April, 2018:

• Crews will continue reconstruction of Meadowbrook Road from just south of Fiddlers Creek Road north to Northview Road. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
