Greetings from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation!


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is well underway with the reconstruction of WIS 241 (S. 27th Street). As part of the reconstruction project, the following upcoming project work and closures are scheduled for the next phase of this project:

All work is weather dependent and subject to change!

Scheduled closures for intersection reconstruction work at S. 27th Street:

- **College Avenue** just west of S. 27th Street recently closed to traffic short-term for paving operations and is scheduled to reopen to traffic late August. Traffic heading westbound on College Avenue will be directed to turn either north or south at S. 27th Street during this closure.
- **Drexel Avenue** just west of S. 27th Street is scheduled to close to traffic short-term for paving operations Tuesday, August 9 and is scheduled to reopen to traffic late August. Traffic heading westbound on Drexel Avenue will be directed to turn either north or south at S. 27th Street during this closure. (See map for details)
