

Project Information

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is making plans to resurface WIS 48 between Knapp Street and North Street in the city of Rice Lake.

A second project will resurface WIS 48 from North Street to County NN, replace portions of curb and gutter, improve drainage pipes, and add left turn bays at County M north and south.

Preliminary design work is underway with final plans expected in the summer of 2014. Construction would begin in the spring of 2015 and will be completed in one construction season

Some of the other details of the project include:

- Addition of curb and gutter
- Replacement and addition of sidewalk
- Construction of a two-way left-turn lane (TWLTL) within the city
- Addition of inlets
- Lining of culvert pipes
- Addition of turn lanes
- New asphaltic pavement

Traffic Control

WIS 48 will be open to traffic during construction. Temporary widening will be performed to accommodate two lanes of traffic within the city of Rice Lake. A moving work zone with the aid of flaggers will be utilized for construction outside of the city limits.
