Yield and choose the correct lane

Yield to vehicles on your left in both lanes of the roundabout because they have the right-of-way.

Multiple signs and pavement markings on every approach remind drivers of the need to choose the proper lane.

Lane signs and road markings indicate vehicles can go straight from either lane.

The aqua car is at fault. This vehicle must yield to vehicles in all lanes in the roundabout, not just vehicles in the outside lane.



Yielding tips

YIELDING TO MOTORISTS

- Slow down as you approach a roundabout.
- Yield to vehicles at your left in all lanes of the roundabout.
- You must come to a complete stop before entering the roundabout if there is no suitable gap available due to vehicles already in the roundabout.

YIELDING TO PEDESTRIANS

- Expect pedestrians when entering and exiting a roundabout, and yield to them at all crosswalks.
- You must come to a complete stop at a crosswalk for pedestrians when they are crossing.
