



WIS 73 Project 0.3 miles north of Pierce Rd. to 0.5 miles north of US 12/18 (Dane County)

Frequently Asked Questions and Answers About the Project Process

Who is conducting the project?

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) – Southwest Region is initiating the project. Local officials from Dane County, affected towns, property owners, and other interested stakeholders will all be involved in the project.

What are the limits of the project?

The project limits extend from 0.3 miles north of Pierce Road and continues north along WIS 73 to 0.5 miles north of US 12/18, a distance of approximately 11.5 miles. The project is located in Dane County.

What is the WIS 73 Project all about?

The WIS 73 Project will address roadway deficiencies along the corridor including poor pavement conditions, drainage issues, substandard vertical and horizontal alignments and intersection safety. The proposed improvements for WIS 73 include replacing and reconstructing the existing pavement/roadway and intersections (including WIS 73/Craig Rd. and WIS 73/US 12/18) and shoulders throughout the corridor. An environmental report (ER) will be completed as part of this project.

When would improvements be made?

WIS 73 is scheduled to be reconstructed in 2014.

How is this project related to the I-39/90 six-lane expansion project?

WIS 73 is a parallel route from I-39/90 to I-94 located east of I-39/90. It has been and will continue to serve as the posted alternate route for I-39/90 traffic.

Future six-lane expansion of I-39/90 from Madison to the WI/IL Stateline includes the removal and reconstruction of the existing freeway lanes and the addition of a third lane in each direction to create a six-lane facility. The interchanges within this segment will be reconstructed to address roadway and capacity deficiencies. Grade separated crossings along the segment are also included in the reconstruction.


How can I get involved and stay informed?

Further meetings for both the general public and local officials are being planned. They offer opportunities for interested citizens to provide input on the issues and the alternatives under consideration. A project mailing database has also been developed. It lists corridor residents/businesses, local officials, agricultural operators, school transportation officials, and other interested parties. All these stakeholders are notified of future public information meetings.
