The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is conducting a public information meeting regarding the proposed improvements to WIS 96 within the village and town of Wrightstown:

Date: Tuesday, May 22, 2012

Time: 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Place: Wrightstown High School Auditorium and Cafetorium, 600 High Street, Wrightstown, WI

Exhibits will be on display in the cafetorium and WisDOT representatives will be available to answer questions. A brief presentation is scheduled to begin at 5:15 p.m. in the auditorium.

The proposed improvements include four construction projects.

During the first project, WIS 96 will be milled and resurfaced from the east limits of the Village of Wrightstown, Shanty Road, to 1,240 feet east of Old 57 Road. The approximate length of the project is 2.2 miles. Work under this project includes milling and resurfacing the two lane facility, widening the paved shoulders, replacing beamguard and end terminals, minor roadside ditch improvements, select cross culvert replacement, and repairing frost heave locations. No additional right-of-way is anticipated. The resurfacing project is currently scheduled to begin in August 2012.

During the second project, WIS 96 (High Street) will be reconstructed from Fair Street to Shanty Road. The approximate length of the project is 0.8 miles. Plans for this project include expanding the existing two-lane urban section with bike and pedestrian accommodations. The design includes new roadway pavement, sidewalks, and storm sewer system. Additional right-of-way and easements will be required. The reconstruction project is currently scheduled for construction in 2014.

The third project will include the reconstruction of WIS 96 (Day Street) from 400 feet west of Lagoon Road to 600 feet east of Breckenridge Falls Boulevard. The approximate length of the project is 0.9 miles. The design includes new roadway pavement, sidewalks, and storm sewer system. The proposed roadway profile will be modified to improve sight distance at the trail crossing east of the roundabout at WIS 32/57. Additional right-of-way and easements will be required. The reconstruction project is currently scheduled for construction in 2014.

During the fourth project, a new WIS 96 bridge will be constructed over the Fox River. Roundabouts will be constructed at the intersection of WIS 96 and Broadway Street and at the intersection of WIS 96 and Turner Street. The existing bridge will be removed. The approximate length of the project is 0.7 miles. Additional right-of-way and easements will be required. The reconstruction project is currently scheduled for construction in 2014 through 2016.

Survey crews will be performing temporary staking of the proposed right-of-way and the proposed temporary limited easements for the reconstruction projects listed above. The survey work is scheduled to take place between May 10 – May 21. These crews will be carrying proper identification that they will share upon request.

Persons with a concern for, or knowledge about, historic buildings and structures, archaeological sites, and general access and property issues are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments. Notice of this meeting has been sent to property owners within the project area.
