WIS 100 BRIDGE REHABILITATION

Work is set to begin Wednesday, April 11 on the rehabilitation of the WIS 100 bridge over the Hank Aaron State Trail. On Wednesday, crews will close the median lane both northbound and southbound on WIS 100 from just north of Theo Trecker Way to I-94. Median removal and building of crossovers is expected to last about 1-1/2 to 2 weeks. Once the crossovers are complete traffic will be switched to place two northbound and two southbound lanes of traffic on the northbound side of WIS 100 in this area. When the switch occurs, the I-94 East exit to WIS 100 South will close (the left turn to WIS 100 north will remain open).

Motorists may exit I-94 East at Moorland Road and take Moorland Road south to Greenfield Avenue to WIS 100 to get around this closure.

Further updates will be provided to detail additional stage changes taking place throughout this project. The bridge rehabilitation is scheduled to be complete in late August.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION
