WIS 100 (Mayfair Road)

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) reconstructed WIS 100 (Mayfair Road) from I-94 to Watertown Plank Road in 2013.

BACKGROUND

Long back-ups and frustrated drivers have been commonplace on WIS 100 for years. Home to major retail, business and health care hubs, this stretch of WIS 100 serves thousands of people every day.

WIS 100 is one of the busiest state highways in the state of Wisconsin with traffic volumes in excess of 30,000 vehicles per day. It is a severely congested roadway and will become more congested during the reconstruction of the adjacent freeway interchange and corridor.

WIS 100 is a major business corridor with thriving local businesses and it serves as a gateway to the largest research park in the area. The Milwaukee County Research Park has 115 businesses which employ nearly 5,000 people.


WHAT'S NEXT?

The roadway was widened to the east. In both the northbound and southbound direction there are four lanes for through traffic and new accommodations for pedestrians and bicycles.

Other features:

- New traffic signal at WIS 100 and Wisconsin Avenue
- Emergency vehicle preemption of traffic lights
- Repaired and lengthened railroad tunnel underneath the WIS 100 and Bluemound Road intersection
- Enhancements such as colored crosswalks and decorative landscaping

The I-94 Interchange at WIS 100 will open in late 2014.
