WIS 100 interchange

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is reconstructing the WIS 100 interchange and adjacent railroad bridge.

BACKGROUND

The WIS 100 interchange serves areas of West Allis and Wauwatosa just north and south of I-94. When the interchange is reopened vehicles traveling on westbound I-94 will exit through the interchange at the loop ramp intersection. This change is being made to reduce the weaving of traffic on the freeway exit ramp and improve safety. Eastbound I-94 traffic operations will function similar to how it operates today..

WHAT'S NEXT?

The adjacent core of the Zoo Interchange will be rebuilt from late 2014 - 2017. During construction, many local ramps will be closed or have less access.

There will be reduced number of lanes on I-94 and additional traffic impacts during the reconstruction of the mainline freeway in 2015-16.

WIS 100 is adjacent to the Zoo Interchange, the busiest and oldest interchange in the state which is being reconstructed through 2018. The Zoo Interchange serves nearly 350,000 vehicles per day and WisDOT is preparing for 40% of the traffic to divert to local roads during construction. WIS 100 will be the major north-south reliever route during the reconstruction of the interchange.
