

ZOO INTERCHANGE NORTH LEG UPDATE

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is slated to begin work on the Zoo Interchange North Leg Project in the coming weeks. The North Leg project includes work along I-41, from Swan Boulevard to Burleigh Street, and is scheduled to conclude in 2023. Several construction activities will take place in and around your neighborhood, including, but not limited to, the reconstruction of the Meinecke Avenue bridge as well as the reconstruction of the North Avenue Interchange. Preparatory work will commence first with tree clearing along the freeway and utility work on 112th and 113th Streets. Additional communication will be sent prior to and throughout the project to keep residents apprised of upcoming closures, stage changes, and other impactful work.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Some construction activities are likely to create vibration, noise, and/or dust. Resident and business access will be maintained throughout the project, but alternate routes will need to be used for periods of time. Be assured that we always work hard to minimize the impact of these events, but if you have a concern, please do not hesitate to contact us.
