

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is continuing work on the 14-mile, I-43 North-South reconstruction project, between Silver Spring Drive and WIS 60 (Washington Street), in Milwaukee and Ozaukee counties.

Construction in 2025 will continue to focus on expansion, improvements, and completion of the Mequon Road Interchange Segment and the South End Segment.

The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project.

### MEQUON ROAD INTERCHANGE SEGMENT

- I-43 freeway reconstruction between Donges Bay Road and Glen Oaks Lane
- Continued I-43 bridge reconstruction over Mequon Road
- Long-term lane closures on Mequon Road under I-43
- Long-term closure of I-43 Southbound ramps at Mequon Road for reconstruction

### SOUTH END SEGMENT

- Project wide restoration, fencing, permanent pavement markings and signage
  - Thin polymer overlays on bridge decks
- Ancillary concrete and restoration on Brown Deer Road

## 2024 CONSTRUCTION RECAP:

### NORTH END SEGMENT

- Completion of I-43 between Highland Road and WIS 60 (Washington Street)
- Restoration, fencing, permanent pavement markings and signage
- Overhead message board installation
- Highland Road final surface pavement
- I-43 opened to three lanes in each direction

### MEQUON ROAD INTERCHANGE SEGMENT

- Continued reconstruction of I-43 between Donges Bay Road and Glen Oaks Lane
- Reconstruction of the I-43 northbound bridge over Mequon Road
- Continued reconstruction of Mequon Road under I-43

### SOUTH END SEGMENT

- Completed reconstruction of I-43 between Bender Road and Brown Deer Road (WIS 100)
- Completed reconstruction of Jean Nicolet Road between Brentwood Lane and Green Tree Road
- Completed reconstruction of Port Washington Road between Bender Road and Coventry Court
- Continued reconstruction of Brown Deer Road (WIS 100), placing traffic into a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) configuration
- I-43 opened to three lanes in each direction

*I-43 North-South is scheduled to remain open to three lanes in each direction, during peak travel time. The Mequon Road Interchange Segment is scheduled to remain open to two lanes in each direction until project completion. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.*
