WIS 50: Geneva Rd, Town of Wheatland

Kenosha County



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will resume construction work along WIS 50 on **28 March 2024**, from the Wisconsin Central RR Bridge to the Fox River Bridge. Work will be complete in three stages and the entire project is scheduled to be completed by early fall.

Stage 1:

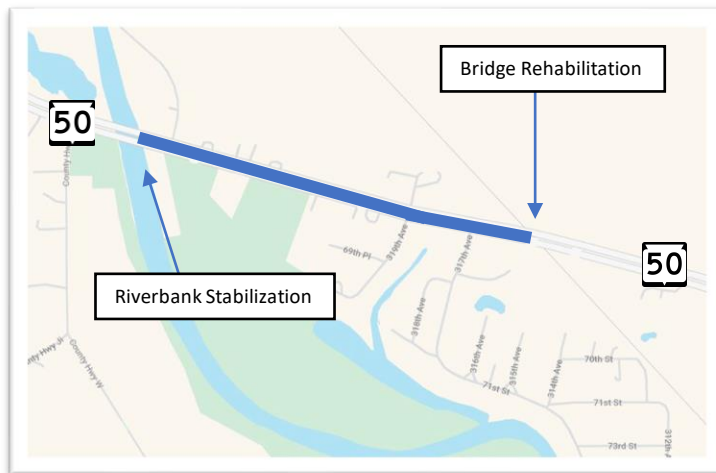
Reconstruct northern lanes.

Stage 2:

Reconstruct southern lanes.

Stage 3:

Remove temporary crossovers and restore medians.



All work is weather dependent. The project team thanks you for your patience and cooperation throughout this project!

Overview

The WIS 50 project will improve approximately 1/4 mile of roadway from the Wisconsin Central RR Bridge to the Bridge over the Fox River.

- Reconstructing pavement from the Fox River bridge to approximately 1350 feet east to mitigate roadway overtopping when the Fox River floods.
- Bridge rehabilitation work of the bridges over Wisconsin Central Railroad and the Fox River.

Traffic Impacts

- One lane in each direction will be maintained on WIS 50 throughout construction.
- Access to local businesses and residences will be maintained
