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Governor Evers approves WIS 91 improvements in Winnebago County

Construction with full closures of WIS 91 begins Monday, Sept. 9

(Oshkosh) To invest in Wisconsin's transportation system, Governor Evers signed three contracts totaling \$1.0 million to improve bridge, culvert, and railroad structures on WIS 91 from just east of WIS 116 in the town of Omro to Clairville Road in the town of Algoma in Winnebago County. Construction begins Monday, Sept. 9. WIS 91 will be closed and detoured in the project limits to through traffic. Construction is expected to finish in late October 2024.

Sheet Piling Services of Custer, Wis. is the Prime Contractor.

Project improvements

This is a structure improvement project. Work includes:

- Replacement of pipe culverts along WIS 91 between James Road and Clairville Road with a new, twin cell box culvert.
 - Work expected over a seven-week duration.
 - This project controls when work will take place at other structures.
- Rehabilitation of the WIS 91 bridge over Waukau Creek including surface repair, polymer overlay, and beam guard replacement.
 - Work expected over a four-to-five-week duration.
- Improvement of the at-grade railroad crossing for WIS 91 at Clairville Road intersection.
 - Work expected over a two-to-three-week duration.

Schedule

- Construction start: September 9, 2024

- Construction expected completion: late October 2024

Traffic impacts

- WIS 91 will be **CLOSED AND DETOURED starting September 9, 2024**. The detour is for thru traffic. Those with a destination in the project work zone please drive carefully and obey all signage.
 - **Detour:** The detour will utilize County M and WIS 44.
- Local, business, and emergency access maintained at all times.

Local Roads

- The intersection of Clairville Road will be closed during railroad crossing work.

Project benefits

At-grade railroad crossing improvements will provide a better, safer crossing for motorists and extend the life of the crossing. New structures will help mitigate possible water on the roadway and minimize future maintenance costs.
