Development Roads Project information

COUNTY H RECONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with the Wisconsin Valley Development Roads projects. As part of these projects, County H, between County KR and Braun Road, will be reconstructed to a four-lane concrete roadway. All lanes of traffic on County H are scheduled to be open by the end of 2019.

UPCOMING WORK BEGINNING MID-MARCH:

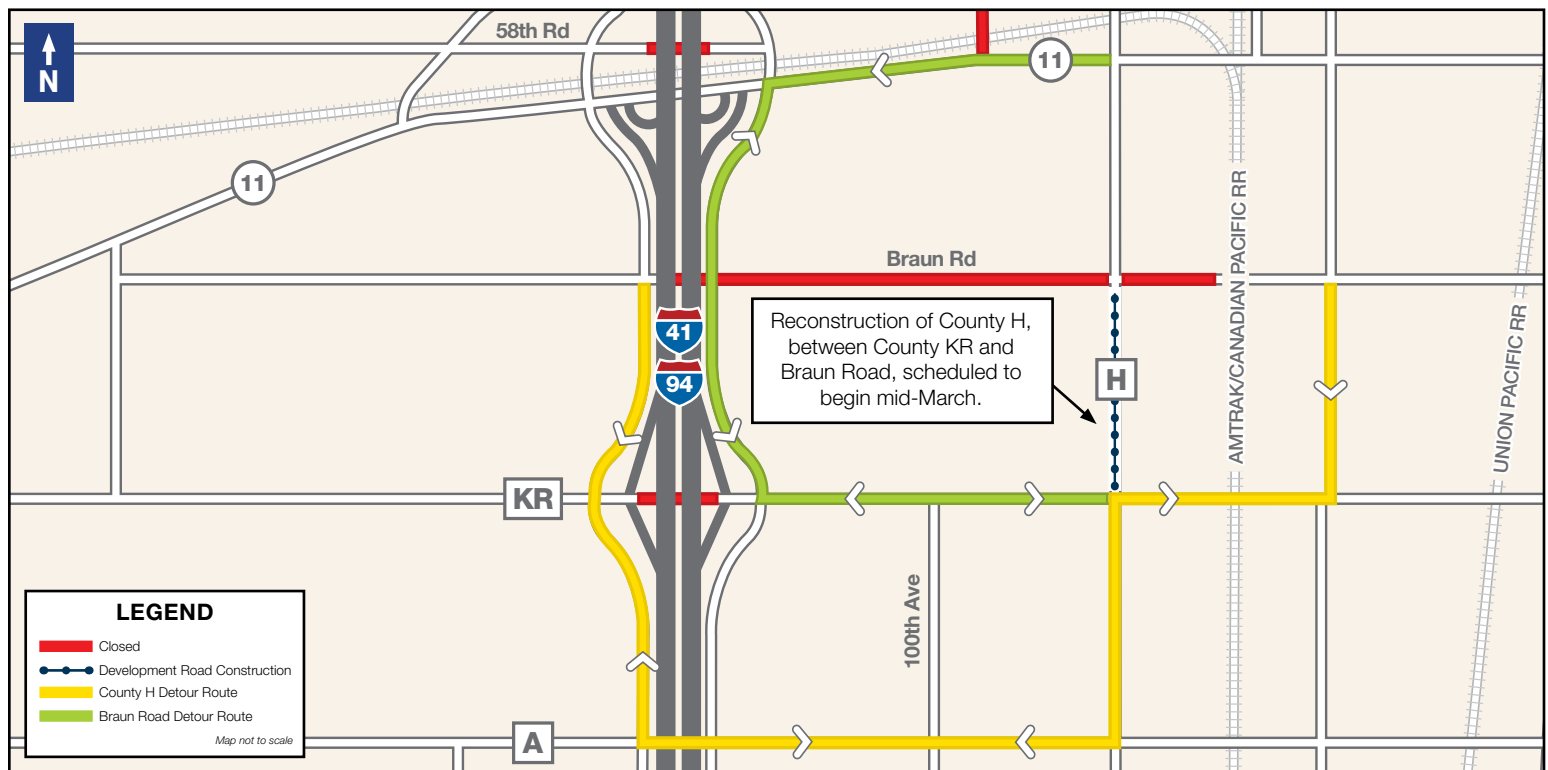
- County H, between County KR and Braun Road, is scheduled to begin reconstruction mid-March. Road work will be completed in 2019 with landscaping complete in 2020.
- Braun Road, east of County H, is scheduled to close as crews work to widen Braun Road east of the intersection.
- Intermittent weekday overnight full closures of County H are anticipated for temporary widening work. Electronic signs on County H will alert travelers in advance of these closures.
- Three weekend full closures of County H, between Braun Road and County KR, are planned for storm sewer work. These closures are expected to take place in March and April. Electronic signs on County H will alert travelers in advance of these closures.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained. Speed limit reduced to 35 mph from south of County KR to WIS 11.

DETOUR ROUTES:

- > Travelers can utilize the East Frontage Road to get around the full closures on County H.
- > Travelers can utilize County KR and County A to get around the Braun Road closure.

All work is weather dependent and subject to change.
