COUNTY KR PROJECT OVERVIEW LATE 2021 - EARLY 2022


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is currently underway with the reconstruction of County KR, between County H and Old Green Bay Road, with all lanes of traffic scheduled to open late summer 2022. Highlights of the schedule are provided below.


WHAT TO EXPECT IN 2022:

- County KR, between County H and WIS 31, will remain closed to traffic to complete reconstruction of the four-lane roadway
- Complete construction of the County KR bridges over the Canadian Pacific Railroad & Union Pacific Railroad
- New signal installation on County KR at the intersection of 90th Street/ 72nd Avenue
- Project restoration

WORK COMPLETED IN 2021:

- County KR, between WIS 31 and just east of Old Green Bay Road, was reconstructed to a four-lane concrete roadway
- Reconstruction of the intersections on County KR at WIS 31 and Old Green Bay Road
- New signal installation on County KR at the reconstructed intersections of WIS 31 and Old Green Bay Road
- Reconstruction of the eastbound and westbound bridges over the Pike River
- Construction of Regenerative Stormwater Conveyance Pond
- Pike River Trail reopened to trail users, between County KR and Braun Road
- County KR reopened to traffic between WIS 31 and the eastern project limits
