## COUNTY KR WORK TO RESUME

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with the County KR reconstruction project. As part of this project, County KR, between County H and Old Green Bay Road, is being reconstructed to a 4-lane concrete roadway. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of the project:

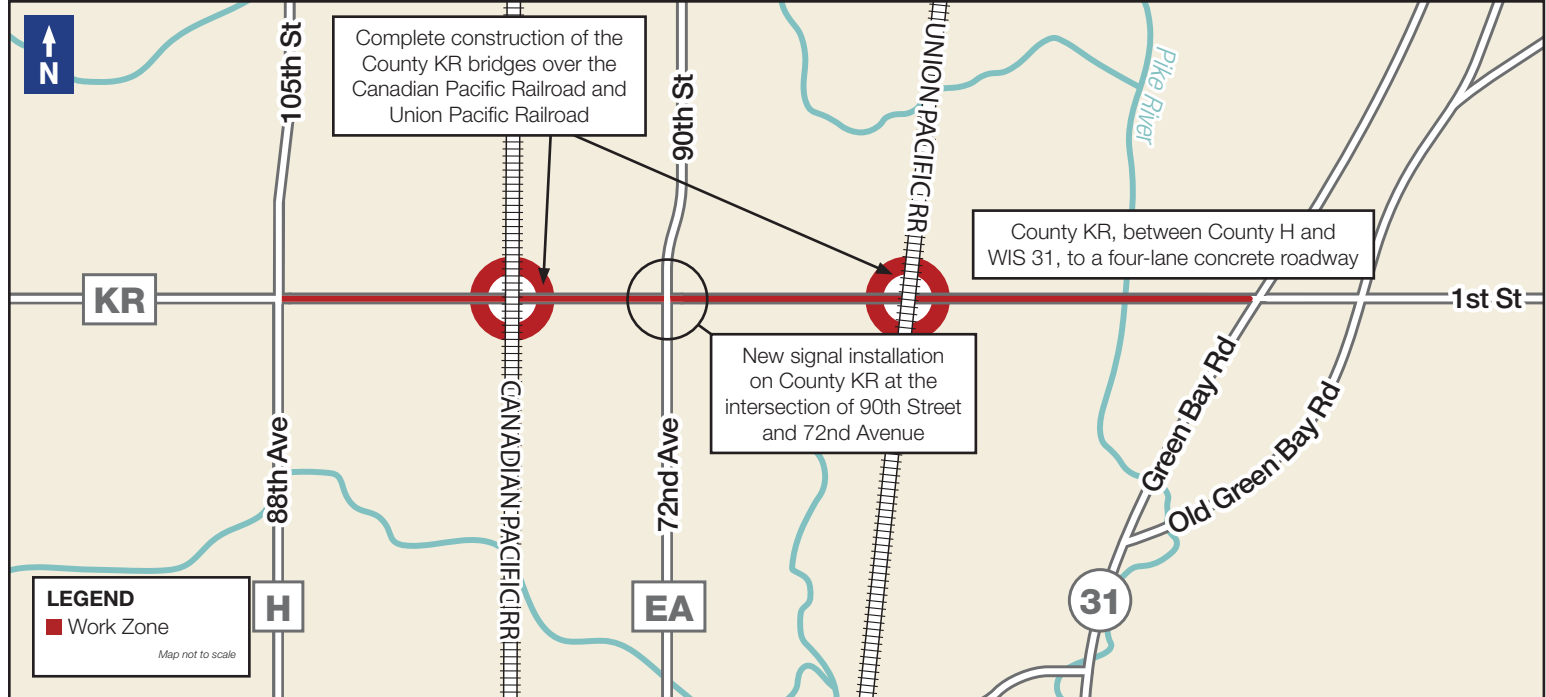
### SPRING 2022:

- County KR, between County H and WIS 31, is scheduled to resume construction beginning early March through fall.

*The contractor is scheduled to return to the project and resuming construction activities anytime after March 1st depending on the weather and site conditions.*

### THE FOLLOWING WORK IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED IN 2022:

- Continue reconstructing County KR, between County H and WIS 31, to a four-lane concrete roadway
- Complete construction of the County KR bridges over the Canadian Pacific Railroad & Union Pacific Railroad
- New signal installation on County KR at the intersection of 90th Street/72nd Avenue
- Project restoration
