COUNTY KR WORK TO RESUME

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with the County KR reconstruction project. As part of this project, County KR, between County H and Old Green Bay Road, is being reconstructed to a 4-lane concrete roadway. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of the project:


SPRING 2022:

 County KR, between County H and WIS 31, is scheduled to resume construction beginning early March through fall.

The contractor is scheduled to return to the project and resuming construction activities anytime after March 1st depending on the weather and site conditions.

THE FOLLOWING WORK IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED IN 2022:

- Continue reconstructing County KR, between County H and WIS 31, to a four-lane concrete roadway
- Complete construction of the County KR bridges over the Canadian Pacific Railroad & Union Pacific Railroad
- New signal installation on County KR at the intersection of 90th Street/72nd Avenue
- Project restoration
