



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 6/30- 7/6

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- ~ **The speed limit on I-39/90/94 will be reduced to 60 mph when crews are working and will return to 70 mph when they are not**
- ~ **County U** over I-39/90/94 closed long-term through **fall 2024** while crews work to reconstruct the bridge
- ~ Northbound and Southbound traffic shifted toward the median to begin work along the outside lanes

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to one lane
- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane
- Overnight rolling closures of I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB)

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to one lane
- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane

Wednesday 7/3

- Only long-term impacts listed above in place

Thursday 7/4

- Only long-term impacts listed above in place

Friday 7/5

- Only long-term impacts listed above in place

Saturday 7/6

- Only long-term impacts listed above in place

- ~ Grading for the new I-39/90/94 Northbound lanes
- ~ Demolition of the County U bridge over I-39/90/94
