

# I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

# **WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 6/30-7/6**

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

# LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 will be reduced to 60 mph when crews are working and will return to 70 mph when they are not
- ~ County U over I-39/90/94 closed long-term through fall 2024 while crews work to reconstruct the bridge
- Northbound and Southbound traffic shifted toward the median to begin work along the outside lanes
