



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 1/26-2/1

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional north of the Wisconsin River

ONGOING WORK

- Grading along the south side of County V
- Pile driving for the new County V overpass bridge
- Retaining wall construction along the new I-39/90/94 northbound lanes south of the Wisconsin River
- Drilled shaft foundation construction for the new northbound river bridge
- Cofferdam construction for the new northbound river bridge

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

Friday 1/31

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Saturday 2/1

- Only long-term impacts listed in place
