



## I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

# WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 3/16-3/22

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

### LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional north of the Wisconsin River

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS WEEK OF 3/16-3/22

#### Sunday 3/16

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Monday 3/17

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes
- I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to two lanes

#### Tuesday 3/18

- I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to two lanes

#### Wednesday 3/19

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Thursday 3/20

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Friday 3/21

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Saturday 3/22

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

### ONGOING WORK

- Grading along the south side of County V
- Retaining wall construction along the new I-39/90/94 northbound lanes south of the Wisconsin River
- Pile driving for the new northbound river bridge
- South abutment construction for the new northbound river bridge
