OVERNIGHT ROLLING CLOSURES AND FLAGGING OPERATIONS

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled for 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

TUESDAY, MAY 13TH FROM 10 P.M. - 5 A.M.:

- **Overnight girder setting for the County V bridge over I-39/90/94**
- **I-39/90/94 is scheduled to be reduced to one lane during these operations**
- **County V will have flagging operations ongoing while the girders are being placed**
- **Short-term rolling closures of I-39/90/94 with law enforcement assistance are scheduled to occur during these operations**

Businesses and residents should be aware that noise and dust are associated with this overnight work.
