



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 7/20-7/26

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2027. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional on the southbound pavement north of the Wisconsin River
- Full closure of County V is scheduled to reopen at 4pm on 7/18

ONGOING/UPCOMING WORK

- Pile driving for the new northbound river bridge
- Pier construction for the new northbound river bridge
- Removal of old County V bridge

TRAFFIC IMPACTS WEEK OF 7/20-7/26

Sunday 7/20

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Monday 7/21

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane
- Overnight I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to one lane

Tuesday 7/22

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane

Wednesday 7/23

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane
- Overnight I-39/90/94 Southbound (EB) reduced to two lanes

Thursday 7/24

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane

Friday 7/25

- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to one lane

Saturday 7/26

- Only long-term impacts listed in place
