



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 12/21-12/27

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2028. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional on the southbound pavement north of the Wisconsin River

No lane closures or traffic impacts are anticipated beyond the existing long-term impacts in place. Construction updates will resume in the New Year.
