



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 2/1-2/7

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2028. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional on the southbound pavement north of the Wisconsin River

ONGOING/UPCOMING WORK

- Pier construction for the new northbound river bridge
- Pavement removals along I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB)

TRAFFIC IMPACTS WEEK OF 2/1-2/7

Sunday 2/1

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Monday 2/2

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Tuesday 2/3

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

Wednesday 2/4

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Thursday 2/5

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Friday 2/6

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Saturday 2/7

- Only long-term impacts listed in place
