



## I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

# WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 4/12-4/18

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2028. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

### LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional on the southbound pavement north of the Wisconsin River

### ONGOING/UPCOMING WORK

- Bridge deck pour for the new northbound river bridge
- Pier construction for the new northbound river bridge
- Installation of bridge deck formwork for the new northbound river bridge
- Grading operations south of the Wisconsin River

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Monday 4/13

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

#### Tuesday 4/14

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

#### Thursday 4/16

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

#### Friday 4/17

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

#### Saturday 4/18

- Only long-term impacts listed in place
