



I-39/90/94 WISCONSIN RIVER BRIDGE PROJECT

WEEKLY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE: 7/19-7/25

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is replacing the I-39/90/94 bridges across the Wisconsin River in Columbia County, with project completion scheduled in 2028. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project:

LONG-TERM IMPACTS IN PLACE

- The speed limit on I-39/90/94 has been reduced to 60 mph at all times
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 has been shifted into temporary lane configurations
- Traffic on I-39/90/94 is bi-directional on the southbound pavement north of the Wisconsin River

TRAFFIC IMPACTS WEEK OF 7/19-7/25

Sunday 7/19

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Monday 7/20

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

Tuesday 7/21

- I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes
- Overnight I-39/90/94 Northbound (WB) reduced to two lanes

Wednesday 7/22

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Thursday 7/23

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Friday 7/24

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

Saturday 7/25

- Only long-term impacts listed in place

ONGOING/UPCOMING WORK

- Installation of bridge deck formwork and reinforcing steel for the new northbound bridge
- Final deck pour for the new northbound river bridge
- Installation of permanent right-of-way fence
